RESOLUTION NO. 95-468

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE KEY WEST SCULPTURE GARDEN MEMORIAL; AUTHORIZING THE DEDICATION OF CITY PROPERTY FOR SUCH MEMORIAL; ESTABLISHING CRITERIA FOR INCLUSION IN THE MEMORIAL; AUTHORIZING "FRIENDS OF MALLORY SQUARE" TO BEGIN DESIGN AND FUNDRAISING EFFORTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to pay tribute to and recognize the contributions of the people who shaped Key West's History; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires the establishment of a permanent Memorial to those significant persons from the past; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires that the Memorial be established at a location of historical significance, preferably near the historic deep water harbor where Key West had its beginnings; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that Mallory Square property adjacent to Tift Warehouse and the Waterfront Playhouse would be a suitable location;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the Key West Sculpture Garden Memorial is hereby established;

Section 2: That the City of Key West is hereby authorized to dedicate public property in Mallory Square for the Memorial, a 62' by 90' area as more particularly set forth in the Appendix "A", attached hereto;

<u>Section 3</u>: That a selection committee established under separate Resolution shall use the following six criteria for inclusion in the Memorial:

- 1. The person must be deceased at least 15 years;
- The person must have made a lasting impact on the history of Key West;
- 3. The person must have served or influenced the community so to have helped shape Key West;
- 4. The person left a legacy;
- 5. The person resided in Key West for at least 15 years;

6. The person reached the age of 40.

Section 4: That the group known as "Friends of Mallory Square" is hereby authorized to begin the task of designing and fundraising for the construction of the Memorial;

<u>Section 5</u>: That final approval of all designs and construction plans is hereby retained by the City Commission.

<u>Section 6</u>: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
