Training & Accomplishments

- Members of the Key West Fire Department Dive Team successfully completed the NAUI Rescue SCUBA Diver Training at the College of the Florida Keys. This specialized course equipped divers with techniques for self-rescue and managing distressed diving emergencies, both above and below the surface.
- The Key West Firehouse Museum hosted a solemn remembrance ceremony to honor those lost on September 11, 2001.
- Tidal Basin provided the ICS 300 course for the Key West Fire Department, City of Key West, and Monroe County Management and Officials. The training is mandatory for all personnel and officials assigned to a command position within the City's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Command Staff.
- Four members of the Key West Fire Department graduated from Paramedic School at Southeastern Medical Academy. They are now preparing for the National Registry Paramedic Exam, which will qualify them to provide advanced life support to the Key West community.
