Dear Ed,

Thank you for meeting with me on Tuesday, May 27th to discuss your offer to incorporate a memorial sculpture of a Black Civil War soldier at the Veterans Memorial Park. I had previously discussed the possibility of incorporating a memorial to Black Civil War soldiers with Clayton Lopez and the members of the Vietnam Veterans Living Memorial Park. The proposal was well received.

The committee has approved a location that is related to, but not within the current Civil War memorial pergola. I have attached the park master plan with the sculpture location identified. The location reflects our onsite meeting and the committee's recommendation.

It is my understanding that you plan to purchase the sculpture directly and have it installed at the appropriate time during construction. We will incorporate the sculpture into our master plan.

Thank you for your generosity. I have copied members of the Vietnam Veterans Living Memorial Park committee and Clayton Lopez. The committee, which is a 501.C.3 corporation, will follow up with a letter on their letterhead.

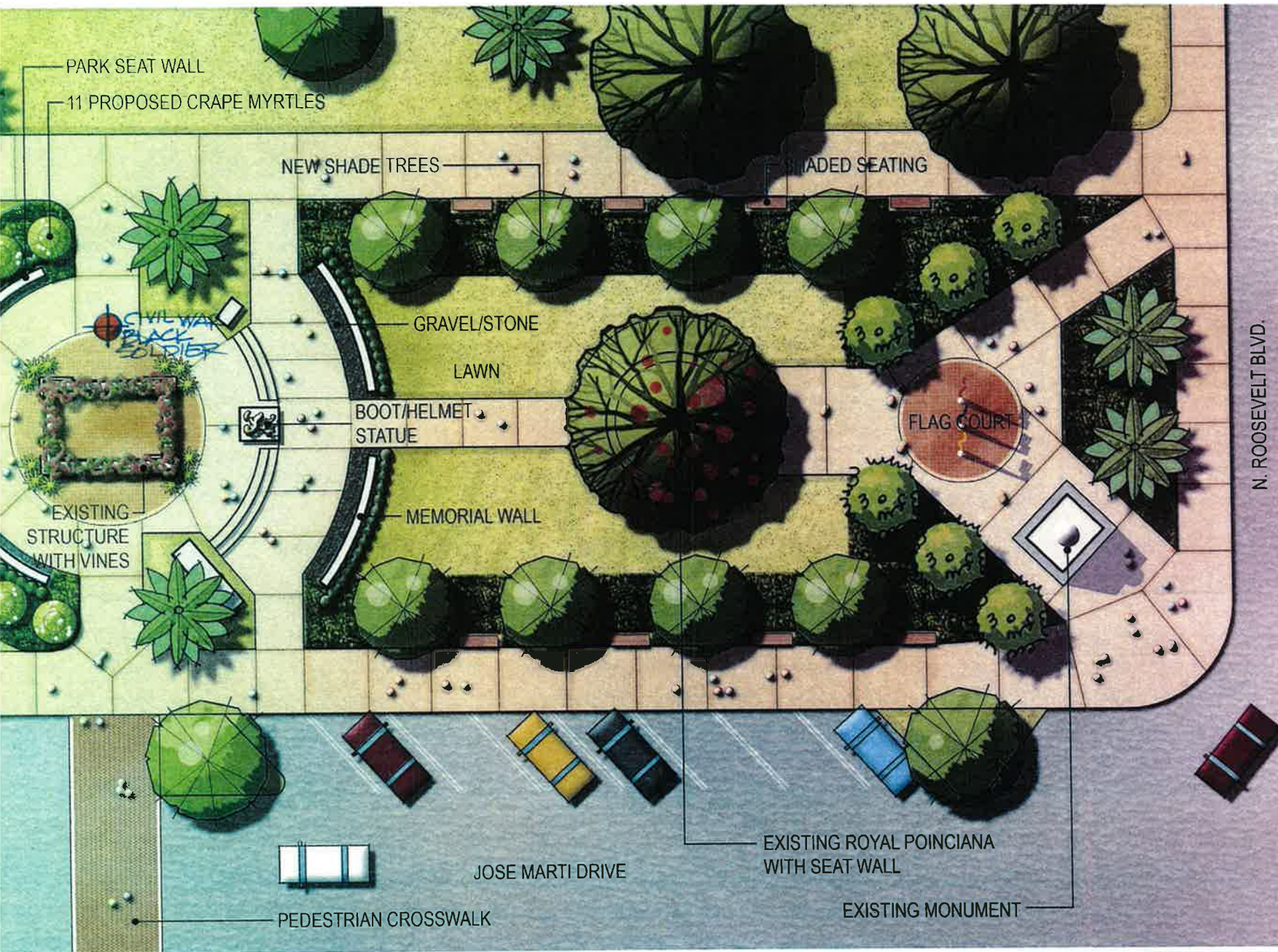
