A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) TO REMOVE COCONUT PALM TREES ALONG THE NORTH ROOSEVELT BOULEVARD PROMENADE AND PLANT GRASS AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation is developing plans to reconstruct and improve certain parts of North Roosevelt and South Roosevelt Boulevard in Key West; and

WHEREAS, in order to complete construction in the most efficient manner, it is necessary to remove landscaping (which consists primarily of coconut trees) along the North Roosevelt promenade;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission hereby requests FDOT to remove coconut palm trees along the North Roosevelt Boulevard Promenade, and to plant grass at the conclusion of the reconstruction project.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
