On 06/25/2022, at approximately 2225 hours, Officer J. Rojas and I (Ofc. A. Litton) were dispatched to 1209 Truman Ave in reference to a domestic battery.

After the domestic violence investigation concluded and the suspect, Frederick Marshall, was placed in handcuffs. Delflora Mashhood expressed her discontent with the results of the investigation regarding an independent witness` testimony that Marshall shoved Mashhood. I explained to Mashhood that Marshall was going to spend the night in jail for domestic battery based upon the witness` statement. I also informed Mashhood that a member of the KWPD would provide her a ride to her hotel room. Mashhood confirmed that her boyfriend was being taken to jail and then stated, "I`ll sit in the jail with him."

Mashhood then attempted to push past me to get to Marshall. I placed a hand on the center of Mashhood`s chest to keep her from getting to Marshall. Mashhood shouted "C`mon babe, we`re going to the jail together!" as she pushed my hand away from her. Mashhood continued to shout that she was going to jail with Marshall. I grabbed Mashhood`s left arm as she pulled away from me. Using Mashhood`s momentum as she pulled away, I redirected her upper body towards the ground while telling her to place her hands behind her back. Mashhood continued to resist as Officer E. Andrade and Officer T. Malak assisted to place her in handcuffs.

After Mashhood was in handcuffs, she stated she did not have the intention to harm any officer on scene, but she did intend to resist so she was placed in jail with her boyfriend. Mashhood suffered minor abrasions on both her knees and complained of her face hurting, possibly from when her "professionally sewed on wig" was ripped from her scalp during the altercation. Sergeant D. Kouri arrived on scene and completed a response to incident report. Key West Rescue was also called to the scene to treat Mashhood`s abrasions on her knees and clear her for transport.

Officer E. Andrade transported Mashhood to MCDC without incident. Axon BWC was activated during this incident and later uploaded to Evidence.com.

Based on her actions during this incident, Mashhood violated FSS 843.01, resisting with violence, when she tried to intentionally push past me to get to another arrestee. Mashhood continued to resist until she was finally placed in handcuffs. Mashhood stated she intended to be placed under arrest for obstruction so she could go to jail with her boyfriend.

On Saturday June 25, 2022, at approximately 2226 hours, I (Ofc Andrade) responded to 1209 Truman Ave, reference a physical disturbance.

Officers Malak, Litton, and Rojas were already on the scene, arriving moments before me.

On arrival I saw Mashhood sitting on a curbed sidewalk in the parking area and Marshall squatting next to her. Standing by them was an unidentified male who walked away from the couple as I approached. Mashhood and Marshall were discussing something. Mashhood was loud and very emotional saying that Marshall was upset because she was scratching another man`s back, adding that they had been drinking and were emotional.

I introduced myself to the Marshall and Mashhood and explained our presence. I aske Marshall to please stand and go and speak with Ofc Malak who was on the opposite end of the curbed sidewalk from where I was, approximately 20 feet away, and he did.

I turned my attention to Mashhood attempting to ascertain what had happened; I could hear Ofc Malak doing the same with Marshall. Mashhood began to address Ofc Malak saying that nothing happened. I asked Mashhood to please allow Ofc Malak to speak to Marshall and she could speak with me. Mashhood continued to speak to Ofc Malak, ignoring my instructions, in a loud and emotional tone saying, "Nothing happened." I had Mashhood stand and move further down the curbed sidewalk away from Ofc Malak. Mashhood then proceeded to recount the matter of her scratching another mans back, adding that Marshall broke a bottle of alcohol, and she began to cry. I then asked Mashhood for her identification, and she provided it.

I then walked over to where Ofc Malak was, instructing Mashhood to stay where she was, and asked Marshall for his identification, which he provided. Mashhood continued to shout out at Ofc Malak and then began approaching his direction. I intercepted her and asked her to step back and to calm down as she began to cry taking multiple short breaths. I walked her back where Mashhood and I were moments ago. Ofc Litton and Ofc Rojas then approached and stayed with Mashhood and I stepped away and communicated with Key West Communications channel two.

I then spoke to the unidentified male who was present on my arrival. He stated that he did not witness any physical altercations, only a loud verbal one. Ofc Litton then approached and informed me that he had identified a witness who observed a physical altercation. I informed Ofc Litton about another witness that Key West Communications had moments ago relayed to me as I was speaking with the unidentified male. I dismissed the unidentified male and thanked him for his time.

I walked across the street and spoke to the witness (Verba) Ofc Litton had informed me about. Verba told me she

witnessed Marshall and Mashhood arguing loudly and then saw Marshall shove Mashhood, call her a "bitch" as she shouted, "What the fuck are you doing! Don't shove me," and then shoved her again. I asked Verba if she would be willing to make a written statement and she said, "Yes." I then gave Verba a witness statement to fill out and walked back across the street to Ofc Litton where Mashhood was again speaking loudly to Ofc Malak telling him to leave Marshall alone. I asked Mashhood to again calm down and stop interrupting, as she was getting irate and becoming very argumentative and belligerent. Moments later Ofc Malak placed Marshall under arrest. Mashhood attempted to make her way to Marshall but was stopped by Ofc Litton. I began to explain to Mashhood the circumstances of the arrest, at her request, when Marshall spoke to her saying, "They are locking me up for domestic battery." Mashhood became even louder saying, "That was a lie." I attempted to explain the circumstances to Mashhood but she interrupted me, and continued to interrupt me several times as I tried to explain so I stopped explaining.

I then walked back to Verba leaving Mashhood with Ofc Litton. As I was speaking with Verba I heard Mashhood yelling aggressively. I turned to face in that direction and saw Ofc Litton struggling with Mashhood, ordering her to put her arms behind her back as she was yelling, "Get off me! Get the fuck off me!" Mashhood was on the ground thrashing around, attempting to evade Ofc Litton's efforts of handcuffing her. I ran to them and immediately took hold of Mashhood's right arm as I ordered for her to stop resisting. Mashhood attempted to pull her arm away from my grasp and attempted to get up going to her knees. Ofc Litton had a hold of Mashhood's left arm and we managed to lay her on her stomach. Ofc Malak came over to assist and held Mashhood's right shoulder. Ofc Litton then handcuffed Mashhood despite her efforts of tensing her torso and arms and pulling against and away from us. While we were struggling with Mashhood, she continued to scream and yell profanities and at one point said, "You are gonna have to kill me tonight." We then sat Mashhood up and told her to stay seated and not stand up.

I went back across the street with Verba to finish obtaining her written statement. Once that was complete, I gave the form to Ofc Litton. Sgt Kouri then arrived on scene and came over to speak to Verba. Sgt Kouri asked Verba about witnessing the use of force on Mashhood. Verba said, "Unfortunately she resisted. Your officers did what they had to do. There was no nasty force. She was very belligerent. There was nothing wrong with what they did." I then thanked Verba for her time and assistance and dismissed her.

Key West Rescue arrived on scene by this point and attended to Mashhood who suffered minor scrapes on her knees during our struggle with her. Key West Rescue cleared Mashhood for transport. Ofc Malak and I then placed Mashhood in the back of my patrol car. I then transported Mashhood to the Monroe County Detention center for processing. My Coban in-car was activated and submitted to the Coban server.

My BWC was activated for this incident and submitted to Evidence.com.

On 6/25/22 at 2223hrs, I, Officer Malak, responded to 1209 Truman Ave, as an assisting unit to a Domestic Battery investigation.

Upon arrival, I assisted Officer Rojas in field his field interview with Fredrick Marshall 3rd. During our interview with Marshall, he was denying any involvement in a physical altercation with his girlfriend, Delflora Mashhood. See officer Rojas` report for complete detail on the interview with Marshall and Mashhood.

Officer Rojas and Litton concluded that an arrest of Marshall was warranted. I assisted Officer Rojas in the handcuffing of Marshall with no complications. Marshall was assisted to the rear of Officer Litton`s patrol vehicle.

While walking with Marshall to Officer Litton`s Patrol vehicle, I heard yelling coming from the area of where Officer Litton and Mashhood were speaking. I observed Mashhood charge at Officer Litton, with Officer Litton taking her to the ground. Officer Andrade ran over to assist Officer Litton in gaining control of Mashhood.

Officer Rojas took control of Marshall, and I went to assist Officer Litton and Officer Andrade. Mashhood was thrashing around, so I placed my hand on the upper part of her back and the back of her head to get her to stop banging it on the ground. Once control was gained of Mashhood, handcuffs were placed on her and she was checked for any injuries. I observed abrasions to both Mashhood`s knees, and she complained of a sore face.

I advised Sgt. Kouri of the incident and he arrived on location to complete the proper RRI paperwork.

I contacted KWFD for a medical evaluation. KWFD arrived and cleared Mashhood of all her medical complaints. Once Cleared, Mashhood was transported to the Monroe County Jail for criminal processing.

I cleared with nothing further.
