Green Commute Challengers
and
Southernmost Beach Resort

During the week of March 27th to April 2nd, ten of the largest employers within the City of Key West took the 3rd Annual Green Commuting Challenge, whereby employees earned points for how they commuted to work. 977 employees reported over 4,000 commutes that week and 66% of all trips were self-powered this year! Highlights include:

- **City of Key West:** 1st Place for employers with 400+ employees
- **Florida Keys Mosquito Control:** 4th place for employers <99 employees
- **Florida Department of Health:** 2nd place for employers <99 employees
- **Florida Keys Community College:** 3rd place for employers <99 employees;
- **Keys Energy Services:** Longest distance bicycled; 2nd place for employers with 100-399 employees.
- **Monroe County Government:** 3rd place in employers with 400+ employees
- **Monroe County School District:** 2nd place in employers with 400+ employees
- **Pier House Resort & Spa:** Best New Participant; 3rd Place overall; 1st place for employers with <99 employees; 1st place carpoolers and hybrids
- **Tropical Soup Group:** Tied 1st for 100% participation; 2nd place overall; 1st place for walkers

Grand Prize winner: Southernmost Beach Resort: Highest average commute score; 1st place in employers with 100-399 employees, Tied 1st for 100% participation; 1st place bikers, bussers, and scooters, 2nd place walkers and carpoolers;
