Diameter: 14"

Location: 20% (growing under neighbors house, roots everywhere)

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 40% (fair canopy, poor root system)

Total Average Value = 53 %

Value x Diameter = 7 replacement caliper (dbh) inches





Diameter: 9"

Location: 20% (major foundation issues) Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 40% (fair canopy, poor root system)

Total Average Value = 53%

Value x Diameter = 4.7 replacement caliper (dbh) inches

Recommendations: Recommend approval for the removal of two strangler fig trees to be replace with a total of 11.7 caliper inches.


