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-- Yusbiel Socarras Arrest Narrative:

On November 13, 2022, at approximately 0335 hours, I (Ofc. Adorno) responded to 425 Greene St reference a battery that occurred at the corner of Duval St and Caroline St.

Upon arrival I met with the reporting party, later identified as Pamela Oropeza. Pamela stated she was at the corner of Duval St and Caroline St at the hotdog station when she was approached by two unknown males. Pamela stated the two males began to speak to her in a nasty manner and mentioned things along the lines of taking her home tonight and performing sexual acts with her. Pamela stated after multiple disrespectful statements from the two males, she decided to tell them to go away. After Pamela told the males to go away, one of the males picked up a traffic cone and struck Pamela to the right side of her rib cage. After the males hit Pamela, she stated they fled the scene and walked toward Mallory Square. Pamela did want to press charges. While speaking with Pamela, the two unidentified males turned the corner of Fitzpatrick St and Greene St. Pamela flagged me down once again and told me she had just seen them around the corner on foot. Pamela was with her boyfriend at the time, later identified as Damon Arrieta.

I exited my patrol vehicle in attempts of speaking with the alleged suspects. The two males were later identified as Damien Chambrot and Yusbiel Socarras. As I turned the corner, I used loud and verbal commands to stop Chambrot. Socarras was still approximately 20 yards east from my current location. Chambrot obeyed my commands and stopped walking. During this time, Socarras continued to walk away.

Pamelas boyfriend (Damon Arrieta) began to walk toward Socarras in attempts to stop him. As Damon got closer to Socarras, Socarras threw one closed right hand punch and hit the right side of Damon`s temple. This caused Damon to immediately fall to the floor. Socarras began to run east toward Front St from Fitzpatrick St. I once again gave Socarras loud verbal commands to stop immediately. I was able to close the distance between me and Socarras in which I then tackled him and redirected him to the ground in a controlled manner where he was taken into custody. I asked Socarras if any medical treatment was needed in which he stated he did not need any.

I requested Sgt. D. Kouri to respond to the scene to conduct a response to resistance investigation. Sgt. D. Kouri arrived and completed his RRI investigation. Socarras was actively resisting, and due to his level of resistance, I had to meet it with what was reasonable and necessary to prevent further risk of harm to himself as well as others around.

Socarras was transported to Monroe County Detention Center without incident and was handed over to Monroe County Deputies for processing.

Damon Arrieta later agreed on pressing charges on Socarras.

Pictures of all injuries were taken and will be uploaded to evidence.com.

My BWC was active during this incident.

Yusbiel Socarras committed the misdemeanor criminal offense of resisting an officer to his / her person without violence as defined in FSS 843.02 - Socarras obstructed us from our lawful duty during a lawful investigation by

fleeing the scene on foot. Socarras was later caught and placed into custody after the foot pursuit.

Based on the facts and evidence:

Yusbiel Socarras actually, and intentionally struck Damon Arrieta against his will contrary to F.S.S 784.03-1A1 - Battery.

Based on the facts and evidence:

Yusbiel Socarras actually, and intentionally struck Pamela Oropeza against her will with a traffic cone contrary to F.S.S 784.03-1A1 - Battery.

Based on the facts and evidence:

Yusbiel Socarras did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S 877.03 Breach of Peace; Disorderly Conduct by purposely disturbing the peace, corrupting the public morals, and initiating a physical altercation with Pamela Oropeza and Damon Arrieta.

On 11/13/2022 at 0343, Ofc. Adorno and I (Ofc. R. Owens) were dispatched to The Bull and Whistle Bar in reference to a battery.

Upon arrival, I was notified the reporting party was no longer at the location. Ofc. Adorno advised his location was Amigos Tortilla Bar, 425 Greene St. While in route to Ofc. Adorno advised that he saw the suspects and they proceeded on foot towards Mallory Square. Upon arrival to the area Ofc. Adorno said he was in a foot chase with a male suspect. I turned my vehicle towards Fitzpatrick St and observed the male suspect running from Ofc. Adorno. I turned my vehicle East on Front St, activated my lights and sirens, and pursued the suspect. The suspect turned off Front St. heading south on Duval and stopped my vehicle at 101 Duval St, CVS Pharmacy. When I stopped my vehicle, the suspect turned back towards me and was taken down to the ground by Ofc. Adorno.

I told the suspect to give me his hands. I assisted Ofc. Adorno in detaining the suspect. After the suspect was detained, I assisted him in standing up and checked him for injuries. I observed an abrasion on his left arm, and small cuts or lacerations on his fingers. I asked Ofc. Bouvier to grab a bottle of water from my patrol car and cleaned the suspects wounds with my first aid kit.

My BWC and AXON in-car were activated for this incident.
