Dear Representatives of the City of Key West:

My partners and I are owners of Hands On, the locally owned, art-to-wear gallery located at 1206 Duval Street. Hands On has operated at this location since 1994.

We object to the Variance Application for 1218 Duval Street for two reasons.

First, we are concerned that the proposed expansion of the bar/restaurant at 1218 Duval Street will significantly increase crowds and noise in our neighborhood. We are happy tenants of the "Duval Street Corridor Cultural District". Our customers appreciate that our location offers a serene oasis unlike the raucous scene typical of other parts of Duval. We want to preserve the character of this section of Duval Street.

Second, we are concerned about parking. Our gallery is a destination for most of our customers. They drive to us. Inconveniencing our customers hurts our business. We opposed this project on the basis that it will increase demand for parking in the neighborhood while decreasing the supply of parking in the neighborhood.


