

RESOLUTION NO. 12-120

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, OPPOSING THE INTRODUCTION OF GENETICALLY-ALTERED MOSQUITOES UNTIL FURTHER RESEARCH IS PROVIDED AND APPROVAL IS OBTAINED FROM THE APPLICABLE REGULATORY BODY, AND OPERATIONAL STANDARDS AND A PLAN TO DEMONSTRATE MEASURABLE OUTCOMES ARE DESCRIBED TO THE PUBLIC; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission is opposed to the introduction of genetically-altered mosquitoes to Key West and the Florida Keys until: further research is provided; approval is obtained from the applicable regulatory body; operational standards are developed; and a plan to demonstrate measurable outcomes are described to the public.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
