City Attorney's Report

The City Attorney thanked his staff and publicly recognized each of them and their hard efforts and contributions to the office during the past year. He also commented on the recent triathlon the City Manager and City associates competed in.

City Manager's Report

City Manager Scholl echoed what the City Attorney stated about staff and the hard work the City Manager's office contributes to the community everyday. He also mentioned the good turn out at the triathlon and congratulated City Planning Department Associates Nicole Malo and Ashley Monnier for making the City Team a success.

The City Manager reminded everyone that today is the National Remembrance Day on the 69<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor. He reported the Florida Keys Assisted Care Coalition (FKACC) met with the City Manager and staff to find a financial analyst company to review FKACC's financial information and City staff had narrowed it down to 2 firms for consideration.

City Manager Scholl gave an update on Monroe County's decision to not use Tourist Development Council (TDC) funds for the development of the Truman Waterfront Marina. The City Manager reported he had a meeting with the Naval Base Realignment team and the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection regarding the Base Realignment closure and the City is looking at the final cleanup of Parcel K.

City Manager Scholl received the Army Corp Reconnaissance Study making this the first step in the long process to consider a dredging project for widening the ship channel.

He recognized interim City Planner Don Craig and thanked Cynthia Coogle and her staff for decorating the City Commission chambers for the Holidays.
