### **Introduction**

The Engineering Department requests approval of a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Task Order in the amount of \$180,122 with Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. for Engineering, Design, and Permitting services for the Atlantic Boulevard Paving Rehabilitation project, dated April 16, 2026, and authorizing the City Manager to execute any necessary related documents and budget transfers/adjustments

### **Background**

Atlantic Boulevard is a city-owned roadway subject to tidal influence and recurring localized flooding, resulting in pavement deterioration and drainage challenges. The City intends to rehabilitate pavement and improve drainage performance to enhance roadway resilience while minimizing impacts to adjacent private properties and environmental resources.

The scope of work includes preliminary engineering, conceptual layouts, design reports, calculations, environmental permit applications (USACE and SFWMD), construction plan sets (60%, 95%, 100%), and an Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction (EOPC), engineering specifications and limited bid phase services.

Environmental evaluations include cultural and archaeological desktop review, tidal elevation review, and coordination with regulatory agencies. Construction-phase services are not included in this Task Order and may be authorized separately.

### **Procurement**

This Task Order is issued under the General Engineering Services Agreement City Commissioned Approved Resolution No. 23-039 with a two-year extension under Resolution No. 26-045. Compensation for this proposed task order is structured as follows:

- Task A (Design Services): Lump Sum – \$161,823
- Task B (Bid Phase Services) – \$6,659
- Permit Fees Allowance: Up to \$750
- Travel Reimbursement Allowance: Up to \$10,890

Total Estimated Task Order Amount: \$180,122

Work will begin within ten days of execution of contract with an estimated design phase of 24 weeks and contract duration including bid phase services of 74 weeks which include construction.

### **Recommendation**

The Engineering Department recommends approval of the resolution authorizing execution of the Task Order in the amount of \$180,122 with Jacobs Engineering Group, Inc. for Engineering, Design, and Permitting services for the Atlantic Boulevard Paving Rehabilitation project and authorizing the City Manager to execute any necessary related documents and budget transfers/adjustments. This project supports the City's strategic priority of Infrastructure and Climate Adaptation by improving roadway resilience, addressing tidal flooding, and enhancing long-term performance of critical transportation corridors.
