Subject: Ratify Purchase Exemption; Change Order to Temporary Security Services Contract

Introduction

Staff requests ratification of the purchasing ordinance exemption for a change order to Temporary Private Security Services contract for the Key West Historic Seaport and City Marina at Garrison Bight, to Florida Keys Security LLC in the amount not to exceed \$75,000 pursuant to Sec. 2-797 of the City of Key West Code of Ordinances executed by the City Manager on June 6, 2025.

Background

Florida Keys Security LLC was issued a temporary private security contract approved by the City Manager in April 2025 upon canceling the existing security services contract due to lack of performance. The temporary contract was not to exceed \$50,000 or extend beyond 6-months of the signed agreement to provide time to publicly advertise a new long-term Private Security Services contract.

Justification

Request for Proposal #25-013 Private Security Service was advertised in April 2025 receiving eight (8) proposals on May 15, 2025. Staff expeditiously reviewed and ranked all eight proposals and have a recommendation for approval that will be submitted for approval to the Key West Bight Management District Board followed by the City Commission and the CRA in August.
