A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA APPROVING THE ATTACHED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE MONROE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT (MCSD) AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA TO ENABLE THE MONROE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE KEY WEST FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE FIREFIGHTING TO STUDENTS DURING THE TRAINING 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR; DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, BUDGET TRANSFERS/AMENDMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Key West Fire Department (KWFD) has provided fire academy training to Key West High School students through the Monroe County School District (MCSD) and Key West High School for the past several years; and

WHEREAS, the Key West Fire Department has enjoyed much success in recruiting high school students with many students graduating from the Academy at the Firefighter I Level in the State of Florida Certification Program; and

WHEREAS, with approval of this Memorandum of Understanding, the MCSD will provide funding in the amount of \$50,000.00 to the City of Key West to compensate for the training provided by Fire Department personnel, at their off-duty, overtime training rate, to provide this important firefighting training to students and adults this coming 2025-2026 school year; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the City Commission approve the attached Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City and the Monroe County School District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission hereby approves the attached Memorandum of Understanding between the Monroe County School District and the City of Key West, Florida, as attached hereto and made a part of this resolution, to provide firefighting training at the Fire Academy at Key West High School for School Year 2025-2025; with \$50,000.00 in funding to be provided by MCSD to the City of Key West, Florida to compensate for the training provided by Fire Department personnel at their off-duty, overtime training rate.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to execute the attached Memorandum of Understanding and other necessary documents and budget transfers/adjustments, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
