A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING WORK ORDER #29 UNDER THE CITY'S RIGHT-OF-WAY IMPROVEMENT CONTRACT WITH CHARLEY TOPPINO & SONS, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$123,345.59 FOR AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS AND RELATED WORK ALONG OLIVIA STREET BETWEEN FRANCES AND WHITE STREET; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 17-106, the City Commission approved a three-year Right-of-Way Improvements contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. and in Resolution 19-054 the Contract was extended; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approval of Work Order #29 to construct ADA compliant sidewalks and related tasks as necessary along Olivia Street between Frances and White Street; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Work Order #29 under the City's Right-of-Way Improvement Contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. in a total amount not to exceed \$123,345.50, ADA sidewalk construction and related work as necessary on Olivia Street between Frances and White Street, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That funding is budgeted for right of way improvements in account 102-4102-541-6300 (Project Number II41021901), and any necessary budget adjustments are hereby approved.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
