-- Logan Paul Thorp Arrest Narrative:

On 10/20/2023 at approximately 2330 hours, Officer Ua and I, Officer Golovanov, were dispatched to 430 Greene Street ("Tiki House") in reference to a trespass incident.

Upon arrival, we met with the subject, who was later identified as Logan P. Thorp. While Ofc. Ua was standing with Thorp, I asked security from the "Tiki House" if they would like to issue Thorp a trespass warning, and security said yes.

I asked Thorp if he had an ID, and Thorp stated no. When I asked Thorp what his name was, he told me that I should know his name. I informed Thorp that he was detained and that I needed to know his name to issue him a trespass warning. At this moment, Thorp became belligerent and started yelling at us that we should already know his name. I informed Thorp that he would be arrested if he did not provide his name. Thorp became even more belligerent after that. Thorp continued to refuse to provide his name. Thorp started to approach Ofc. Ua and keep yelling at us.

At this moment, Ofc. Ua and I decided to handcuff Thorp for officer safety. We gave Thorp multiple loud verbal commands to put his hands behind his back. Thorp refused to comply, so I grabbed Thorp's right arm and Ofc. Ua grabbed Thorp's left arm in an attempt to place Thorp's arms behind his back. I could feel Thorp tense his right arm, trying to pull away from me. Ofc. Ua and I repeatedly advised Thorp to stop resisting, but Thorp refused.

Ofc. Ua forcibly guided Thorp to the ground, and I handcuffed Thorp while he was in the prone position on the ground.

Ofc. Ua searched Thorp and retrieved a Smith and Wesson revolver (serial number: J408213) from Thorp's front pocket. I placed Thorp in the back of my patrol car. I checked the serial number of the revolver on KWPD channel 2.

I transported Thorp to MCDC without incident.

My Axon B.W.C. and in-car recording system were activated during this incident and later uploaded to Evidence.com.

Based on the facts and evidence of this case, Logan P. Thorp violated FSS 843.02 RESISTING OFFICER WITHOUT VIOLENCE. Logan P. Thorp obstructed us from our lawful duty during lawful detainment and arrest by actively resisting. Logan P. Thorp tried to defeat our attempts to place him in handcuffs by tensing up and pulling his arms away from us.

Based on the facts and evidence of this case, Logan P. Thorp violated FSS 843.02 RESISTING OFFICER WITHOUT VIOLENCE. Logan P. Thorp obstructed us from our lawful duty during lawful detainment by not providing us his name, even after warning that he would be arrested.

To be noted, the MCDC deputy did a "CCH" check and did not reveal any previous felony charges on Thorp. Based on that, Thorp's Smith and Wesson revolver (serial number: J408213) will be packaged and submitted to the Key West Police Department Property & Evidence Division under the status "Return to Owner."

Thorp was issued a trespassing warning from 430 Greene Street ("Tiki House").

On October 20, 2023, at approximately 2330 hours, Officer Golovanov and I, Officer Ua, were dispatched to 430 Greene Street ("Tiki House") in reference to a trespass incident.

Upon arrival, I met with the subject, who was later identified as Logan P. Thorp. While I was talking to Thorp, Officer Golovanov asked security from the Tiki House if they would like to issue Thorp a trespass warning, and security said yes.

Officer Golovanov met with Thorp and I after talking with security. Officer Golovanov asked Thorp for identification, but he was being difficult and uncooperative with Officer Golovanov and I. Thorp kept saying he met with me the night prior but was mistaken. Thorp met with Officer Adorno and Officer Thornbrugh the night before. Thorp was under the influence of alcohol as I could smell the odor emanating from his breath while listening to him talk over Officer Golovanov. Thorp kept saying to Officer Golovanov and me, that we knew his name, but we had no idea who he was. Officer Golovanov advised Thorp if he didn't provide identification or a name and date of birth, he would be arrested. Thorp continued to be belligerent towards Officer Golovanov and I. Officer Golovanov and I looked at each other and decided to arrest Thorp for not providing identification or name and date of birth.

Officer Golovanov told Thorp to place his hands behind his back. Officer Golovanov grabbed his right arm, and I grabbed his left arm to control his hands behind his back. At this time Thorp began resisting and tensing his arm and hands to restrict us from handcuffing him. Thorp began yelling and cursing at us while continuing to resist being handcuffed. I took control of Thorp's right arm and forced him to the ground to better control both of his hands while Officer Golovanov handcuffed him while he was on the ground on his stomach. Officer Golovanov handcuffed Thorp and then I guided him to his feet and into Officer Golovanov's patrol car. While Thorp was in the patrol car seated, I conducted a search for weapons and contraband. I pulled out a revolver handgun from his front right pocket and phone from his front left pocket.

After the search of Thorp, Officer Golovanov transported Thorp to MCDC for violation of Resisting an Officer Without Violence. BWC 4264 was activated during this call and later uploaded Evidence.com.

After reviewing my BWC video from the incident, I wanted to add several corrections to my report.

When Thorp started to approach Ofc. Ua and keep yelling at us, Ofc. Ua and I decided to handcuff Thorp for officer safety. I grabbed Thorp's right arm and Ofc. Ua grabbed Thorp's left arm in an attempt to place Thorp's arms behind his back. I could feel Thorp tense his right arm, trying to pull away from me. Ofc. Ua forcibly guided Thorp to the ground, and I handcuffed Thorp while he was in the prone position on the ground. Ofc. Ua and I placed Thorp inside of my patrol car. Thorp continued to be belligerent and yelled at us. At one point, Thorp yelled: "Fucking die, bitch!" while he was inside my patrol car. In the several minutes, Ofc. Ua tried to talk to Thorp through the rear window, but Thorp yelled: "Shut a fuck up!"

Ofc. Ua searched Thorp while he was in the back of my patrol car and retrieved a Smith and Wesson revolver (serial number: J408213) from Thorp's front pocket. I checked the serial number of the revolver on KWPD channel 2.
