A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, REQUESTING THAT THE TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA ESTABLISH AN EROSION CONTROL LINE ALONG APPROXIMATELY 640 FEET OF REST BEACH IN CONFORMANCE WITH CHAPTER 161, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, the Key West City Commission supports the Department of Environmental Protection's beach and coastal management programs; and

**WHEREAS**, portions of Key West are designated by the Department of Environmental Protection as a "critically eroded" shoreline; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Key West has developed a local beach management plan including the nourishment of a critically eroded beach known as Rest Beach; and

**WHEREAS**, as a condition of the Department's Joint Coastal Permit for this Renourishment Project, the Key West City Commission recognizes the need to establish an Erosion Control Line along Rest Beach; and

**WHEREAS**, the Key West City Commission recognizes that it is required to conduct a public workshop immediately preceding the hearing for the purpose of discussing the proposed renourishment project and establishment of the proposed erosion control line with the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Key West City Commission shall, in coordination with the Bureau of Beaches and Coastal Systems, publish "Notification of the Public Workshop and Public Hearing" as follows:

- Notice will be published in a local paper once a week for three consecutive weeks prior to the public workshop and hearing
- Notice will be published in the Florida Administrative Weekly at least one week prior to the public hearing; and
- Notice will be sent certified mail to all riparian owners of property located within 1,000 feet of the proposed erosion control line.

Section 2: That the Commission hereby requests that the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Fund of the State of Florida approve and establish an Erosion Control Line along approximately 640 feet of the Rest Beach project shoreline in conformance with Chapter 161, Florida Statutes..

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
