

RESOLUTION NO. 24-02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY BOARD
OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RECOMMENDING
PRIORITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Resolution 09-024 created the Sustainability Advisory Board to Advise and assist the City Commission in efforts to make City operations and the community as a whole more sustainable; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting held June 4, 2024, the Sustainability Advisory Board finalized its annual priorities for fiscal year 2025; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SUSTAINABILITY ADVISORY BOARD OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Sustainability Advisory Board recommends the following priorities to the City Commission.

- 1) Increase Resiliency of Our Island
 - i. Implement ESCO program to reduce energy/water use
 - ii. Implement Resiliency Fee
 - iii. Develop stronger building codes for wind and flood
- 2) Increase Reduce & Recycling Efforts
 - i. Mandatory & Incentivized Recycling for Businesses
 - ii. Hire Recycling Coordinator
 - iii. Research and develop a plan to increase local composting
- 3) Less Cars on the Road
 - i. Hire Sustainable Transportation Coordinator
 - ii. Increase and enforce alternative transportation education and safety regulations
 - iii. Create additional permanent funding for Transit (4)
- 4) Environmental Protection (14)
 - i. Decrease imperviousness by adopting Best Management Practices for stormwater
 - ii. Increase CFK Funding for Water Quality Monitoring Equipment
 - iii. Complete Ten-Year Energy Plan (3)

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and Clerk of the Sustainability Advisory Board.
