

RESOLUTION NO. 18-122

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(4)(b) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES THE PROCUREMENT OF ONE FORD F-250XL FOUR WD DIESEL CREW CAB PICKUP TRUCK WITH ACCESSORIES FROM KEYS AUTO SALES, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,277.00, FOR USE BY THE KEY WEST POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City staff obtained two price quotes pursuant to government contract, and one local price quote for purchase of a 2019 Ford F-250, and determined that the local price quote was substantially lower than the government contract quotes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code Section 2-797(4)(b), the City Manager finds that exceptional circumstances exist to exempt a purchase from the competitive bid requirements in the best interests of the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the procurement of one Ford F-250XL Four WD Crew Cab Pickup Truck with accessories from Keys Auto Sales, in an amount not to exceed \$40,277.00 is hereby awarded pursuant to Section 2-797(4)(b) of the Code of Ordinances, for use by the Key West Police Department.

Section 2: That funds for this purchase are budgeted in the FY 17-18 budget under 101-2101-521-6400.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.


