

RESOLUTION NO. 25-201

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) ENVIROSIGHT OUTPOST PIPELINE CAMERA SYSTEM WITH RELATED ACCESSORIES IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$137,254.00 FROM ENVIRONMENTAL PRODUCTS GROUP, INC THROUGH PIGGYBACKING ON THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION AND FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES BID NO. FSA23-EQU21.0, HEAVY EQUIPMENT CONTRACT, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(3) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR USE AT THE RICHARD A. HEYMAN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FACILITY (RAHEPF) AND ASSOCIATED COLLECTION SYSTEM; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, this purchase will be made under the Florida Sheriffs Association and Florida Association of Counties Bid No. FSA23-EQU21.0 Contract, pursuant to section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the purchase of one (1) EnviroSight Outpost Pipeline Camera System and related accessories as described in the attached proposal from Environmental Products Group, Inc., pursuant to section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances, under the Florida Sheriff's Association and Florida Association of Counties FSA23-EQU21.0 Heavy Equipment Contract, in a total amount not to exceed \$137,254.00, is hereby authorized for use by Jacobs at RAHEPF.

Section 2: That funds for the purchase of this equipment are budgeted in FY 24/25 Construction in Progress 401-3504-535-6500 /SE35042402 Asset Management Development. Any related and necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the

Commission.
