A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "EXHIBIT A" (2018-19) TO THE "STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE AND COMPENSATION AGREEMENT, CONTRACT ARU46"; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the Agreement requires an annual update to Exhibit A of the Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Exhibit A (2018-19) to the "State of Florida Department of Transportation Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement, Contract ARU46" is hereby approved.

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents on behalf of the City of Key West, upon consent of the City Attorney.
