A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE
NAMING OF AN ALLEYWAY BEHIND KINO PLAZA AS
"KINO ALLEY"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Roberto T. Lopez opened the original Kino Shoes in
1965 on Whitehead Street; and

WHEREAS, in 1974, Mr. Lopez purchased the property on the
corner of Greene and Fitzpatrick Streets, creating Kino Plaza; and

WHEREAS, today Kino Sandals employs more than 30 people who
continue the Kino legacy. Key West is known for the Kino Sandal
Factory, and Kino is known for Key West; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the alleyway behind Kino Plaza is hereby
named "Kino Alley."

Section 2: That this approval grants no others rights to the
applicant or creates any obligations of the City.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
