A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE BAHAMA VILLAGE MUSIC PROGRAM, INC. TO HOLD THE 11TH CROOKS ANNUAL SECOND LINE PARADE ON SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 15, 2026, FROM 12:00 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M. (SETUP AT 11:00 A.M.) ON DUVAL STREET; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS OR PORTIONS THEREOF FOR SAID PARADE FROM 12:00 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M.; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Bahama Village Music Program, Inc. wishes to conduct the "11th Crooks Annual Second Line Parade" on Duval Street from the Hog's Breath Saloon to the Green Parrot on Southard Street during the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (setup at 11:00 a.m.) on Sunday, February 15, 2026.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily

recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "To go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That the Bahama Village Music Program, Inc. is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place at the time and place as herein described; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that the organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That the Bahama Village Music Program, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 5. That the Bahama Village Music Program, Inc. acknowledges that they are responsible for payment to the Key West Police Department, the Key West Fire Department and Community Services.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and Clerk of the Commission.
