A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE TRANSPORTATION GRANT ATTACHED "PUBLIC FLORIDA AGREEMENT" (PTGA) BETWEEN THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR (SFY) 2024 FTA SECTION 5311 RURAL OPERATING GRANT TO PROVIDE FIXED BUS ROUTE SERVICES AND ON-DEMAND SERVICE IN THE CITY OF KEY WEST AND STOCK ISLAND, PTGA G2P96 / FINANCIAL PROJECT #434896-3-84-02 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,690,355.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS AND NECESSARY BUDGET AMENDMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in Resolution 23-113, the City Commission authorized certain City staff to apply for grant funding and to execute and submit grant documentation through the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Public Transportation Grant Agreement" (PTGA #G2P96 / FM #434896-3-84-01) for Section 5311 Formula Grants for Rural Operations funds for the fixed bus route services for SFY2024 between FDOT and the City is hereby approved in the amount not to exceed to \$1,690,355.00.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
