On Monday October 25, 2021, at about 214 am, I, (Ofc. L. Hernandez), was dispatched to 423 Caroline Street, in reference to domestic battery and disorderly conduct incident, involving a male and female.

Upon arrival, I pulled up with my patrol vehicle, across from the location of the where the incident was reported. My patrol vehicle overhead lights were turned on and I activated my BWC (3452) before I stepped out of my patrol vehicle. As I was walking across the street, I could see a group of about 10 persons, yelling and screaming.

A female that was standing alone, away from the group, pointed me towards the group. I asked the female if they were fighting, and she told me "the female and the male that are together". I rushed towards the group because I observed a female, later identified as Devyn Maree Cordell (DOB 08/02/1997), throw an opened hand right hook that landed on her boyfriend's face. Cordell's boyfriend was later identified as Jake Anthony Durrant (DOB 08/20/1997). I walked up to both Cordell and Durrant and tried to separate them from the rest of the group, identifying myself as a Key West Police Officer while giving them loud commands to get back and away from the group. I had to get in between the group and them to keep them from causing more issues. My commands were loud and clear and had to be due to the ambient noises and all the noises coming from the music of the surrounding bars and restaurants. I was wearing my Key West Police issued Class B uniform which clearly identifies me as a law enforcement officer.

Both Cordell and Durrant did not comply with my lawful orders. They both started to scream from the top of their lungs. They were both under the influence of alcoholic beverage (s) as per their irrational and belligerent behavior, slurred speech and strong odor of alcoholic intoxicant (s) emanating from their breath. Durrant screamed at me "do not touch her, she is my girlfriend", at that point I was only giving them lawful orders to get back. Ofc. K. Waite arrived on scene and ordered Durrant to place his hands behind his back to try to detain him and place him in handcuffs. Durrant resisted by tensing up, pulling away from Ofc Waite and knocking my BWC off my chest. I started to assist Ofc. Waite with placing Durrant's arms behind his back.

I then saw Cordell, who was to my right, start to come towards us, closing in between 4-6 feet from us, screaming and yelling. I ordered Cordell to get back and she resisted by continuing to close in on us. I grabbed Cordell by her left arm and told her to place both arms behind her back. Cordell resisted my pulling away and tensing up. Cordell kept screaming from the top of her lungs "don't touch me, don't touch me" while resisting. I kept telling Cordell to stop resisting but she continued to resist. I removed Cordell's purse from her right shoulder and had to take her down to the ground in a control manner to detain her. As I began to place handcuffs on Cordell, I saw that Durrant got lose from Ofc. Waite's lawful attempts to place him in handcuffs and Ofc. Waite deployed his taser at Durrant. Ofc. Waite staser deployment did not make a successful contact with Durrant. I saw Durrant walking towards Ofc. Waite after the deployment of the taser in an aggressive manner and fighting stand. I also deployed my tase towards Cordell. My taser deployment was also unsuccessful in making contact with Durrant. Ofc. Waite then took Durrant down to the ground and had to use his taser in the drive stun mode. I placed Durrant in handcuffs. During the take down, Durrant sustained a bloody nose, facial scratches, and a scraped above his right eye. Ofc. Waite placed Cordell in handcuffs. Multiple people were gathering in the area of the incident and I could hear them telling Cordell and Durrant "stop fighting the police, stop resisting".

Ofc. Waite had to place a hobble on Durrant as he was trying to defeat our attempts to get him in a recovery position (on his side), after being handcuffed, to prevent him from kicking us. Durrant was intentionally tensing his legs up and moving side to side. During all of this Durrant kept cursing at us and calling us derogatory names and making threats "you guys are bunch of pussies, if you remove this handcuffs, you guys are being assholes, you bald pig, punk ass bitch, fucking rapists, let her go". Durrant kept asking Cordell if she was okay and she told him "shut the fuck up".

Key West Fire Rescue 2 arrived and provided on scene medical services to Durrant. I conducted a search incident to

arrest of Durrant before placing him in Ofc. Waite's patrol vehicle. Once inside Ofc. Waite patrol's vehicle Durrant placed his head up against the partition and spat blood into the front seat at least four times and called us "fucking faggets". I removed Durrant from Ofc. Waite's patrol vehicle and placed him in mine. Durrant

The level of force Ofc. Waite and I had to apply to get Durrant and Cordell to comply with our lawful orders and arrest attempts was reasonable and necessary to bring a volatile situation under control and to keep ourselves, Cordell, Durrant and others safe. Durrant and Cordell continued to resist us aggressively, caused a public disturbance by fighting, screaming, trying to assault others and all while being highly of intoxicated.

Sgt. A. Rodriguez, Ofc. R. Perez and Ofc. D. Agleeve arrived on scene and began to assist us. According to several eyewitnesses, during the domestic dispute and disorderly behavior Cordell and Durrant engaged in, a scooter owned by Thembinkosi Vincent Bhuca (DOB 04/08/1992) left mirror was damaged. Ofc. Perez met with two independent witnesses that provided sworn written statements of the incident prior us arriving on scene. Jessica Anne Larson (DOB 07/18/1985) and Eric Brian Meyer (DOB 07/24/1983) both provided sworn written witness statements. Larson's witness statement describes a mutual domestic physical dispute between Cordell and Durrant; it also reads that Durrant shoved and assaulted "several of the witnesses". Larson said she informed them she had contacted Key West Police and that they should leave. Instead, Larson said "they continued to fight, and he stood like he was going to shove me".

Meyer witness statement describes Durrant by the clothing he was wearing, which was black plants and black t-shirt. Meyer statement reads that Durrant "was being destructive to park scooters and tried to pick a fight with the owner, antagonized the owner and others. Meyer also said he got shoved by Durrant but that he did not sustained any injuries.

Cordell and Durrant are in a dating relationship for about 5-6 years and reside together, according to Durrant. This incident meets the criteria of domestic violence as per F.S. 741.28 (3). Cordell was determined, and by independent witness statements, to be the primary aggressor and offender of the domestic battery incident.

Based on all evidence, facts and totally of circumstances, I believe that on October 25, 2021 Cordell committed the following criminal offenses:

- \* Resist Officer with violence as described in F.S. 843.01 Felony offense. Both Durrant and Cordell resisted arrest by trying to defeat our attempts to make lawful arrests.
- \* Disorderly Conduct as described in F.S. 877.03 Misdemeanor offense. Both Durrant and Cordell breached the peace, corrupted the public moral and engaged in fighting in front of several eyewitnesses and people that were gathering and passing by.
- \* Battery as described in F.S. 784.03 Misdemeanor offense. Cordell committed domestic battery on her boyfriend Durrant by striking him against his will.

I transported Durrant to the Monroe County Detention Center and Ofc. Agleev transported Cordell. They were both turned over to Detention Deputies without further incident. The nurse at the Detention Center refused Durrant asking for hospital clearance. I transported Durrant to the Lower Keys Medical Center. Nurses and ER on duty doctor interviewed and provided medical services to Durrant, subsequently clearing him to be transported back to the Detention Center. I transported Durrant to the Detention Center and he was booked.

My BWC and Axon Fleet (3452) were both activated during this incident. End of arrest report. Nothing further at this
