On 10-29-2021, I K-9 Ofc. Matthew Hansell of the Key West Police Department, was blocking the roadway at Windsor Lane and Galveston Lane in reference to a tree down across the roadway during a heavy thunderstorm.

The large tree had fallen from 727 Windsor Lane, pulling the power box from the side of the same residence and falling into the power lines directly across the street. The tree covered the whole roadway not allowing any traffic to pass.

Ofc. Wynn was providing traffic control at Windsor Lane and William St. I was standing in front of 719 Windsor Lane, when I saw a male / suspect, walking in the middle of Windsor Lane toward my direction from Elizabeth St. The male was approximately 6ft tall weighing around 160 to 170 pounds. He had very short brown hair and was an average to slight thin build. He was only wearing dark colored shorts no shirt with white shoes.

The suspect was flailing his arms and yelling incoherently. As he approached my K-9 patrol vehicle he started hitting the driver side rear window as he continued to approach me.

I immediately challenged him and told him to get away from my vehicle and what his problem was. The suspect looked at me with a far off look in his face as if he was staring right through me while yelling, "What the fuck it's just a tree, we are one human family.!"

The suspect began to fight with me as we both became locked up. The suspect flailed his arms at me forcefully pushing away as I lost my grip due to the amount of water on him from the rain. I tried one last grab of the suspect before he reached the power line and tree, but was unsuccessful.

Unfazed by my attempts to stop him, the suspect pushed his way through the tree touching the downed power box, causing a huge power surge that popped and exploded. I could feel the electricity from the explosion in my arms and head.

I backed away from the tree and yelled to Ofc. Wynn, who was on the other side, to stop the suspect. I watched as Ofc. Wynn and the suspect began to struggle with each other before the male ran toward Passover Lane and Windsor Lane with Ofc. Wynn chasing on foot.

I went to my patrol vehicle and backed down the street turning onto Elizabeth St. and headed toward Truman Ave. Other Officers arrived in the area and began actively looking for the suspect.

I provided a BOLO of the suspect over Key West Dispatch Channel 1.

While circulating the area, Ofc. Roscoe saw the suspect walking near Don's Place. I proceeded to the area as several officers began chasing the suspect on foot. The suspect became engaged in another altercation with officers in the back parking lot of The Bike Shop on Varela St. and was able to get away. See Officer supplement reports for details.

The male continued running South on the West side of Varela St. toward Virginia St. I turned onto Varela St. and saw the male running from officers. I pulled to the end of Varela St. at Virginia St., exited my K-9 patrol vehicle with K-9 Dexter and proceeded North down the side walk in the direction of the suspect. By this time the suspect had jumped a fence South approximately mid block and was out of my sight.

I met with Ofc. Roscoe and asked where the suspect ran to. Ofc. Roscoe could only provide a general area where he thought the suspect ran. I took K-9 Dexter to group of cottages at 1012 Varela St. I gave a K-9 announcement and began clearing the property without locating the suspect. I also cleared 1016 and 1018 Varela St..

I came out from the residence as K-9 Dexter took me South on Varela St. and back West on Virginia St. At almost the same time, Ofc. Malek said he had an open gate and knocked over Halloween Decorations on Watson Lane., directly behind the houses I initially cleared.

I checked the houses on Watson Lane without locating the suspect. After clearing the Church with an open gate on Watson St., I put K-9 Dexter back in our K-9 patrol vehicle for a quick break. See K-9 Usage report 21-6040 for details.

K-9 Ofc. Anglin arrived on scene to assist as more officers arrived to help with a perimeter. I assisted Ofc. Anglin and K-9 Jigsaw with checking several residence on Varela St. and Watson Lane. After clearing the area the perimeter was released. See Ofc. Anglin K-9 Usage Report 21-6039 for details.

I returned to the station and completed the initial report.

Ofc. Wynn sustained several injuries while attempting to stop the fleeing suspect and was taken to Lower Keys Medical Center for treatment.

On 10-30-2021, I was contacted by a homeowner at 1012 Varela St. unit # 3., who said she had shoes on her roof possibly left by the suspect. I met the homeowner at her residence, a single story cottage to the North of 1014 Varela St. The cottage shares a common walking bath that you enter through a closed white picked gate with no lock. The pathway is covered in paver stones outlined with gravel. There are several closed gates which lead to other units toward the back of the property.

The homeowner told me the following. She had heard what she believed someone climbing on her roof a few minutes before we began searching her yard. Her husband told her it was probably just an iguana, however the homeowner was adamant it was a person. Her husband eventually left for work and Officer's cleared the area twice before leaving.

The homeowner, who wishes to remain anonymous, said after police left she heard what sounded like someone climbing down from the roof. She told me she stayed in her house at the time and did not say anything to police because she was told to stay inside. She told me her next door neighbor called her today and said she could see two white shoes and a sock on her roof from her second floor window. The homeowner said she sweeps her roof once a month and did not notice anything up there before..

I used a ladder and climbed up onto the roof capturing the scene with my body camera. I retrieved the shoes and a gray sock using latex gloves. The shoes are white Nike men's Air Jordans size 11. The sock was a gray ankle sock.

Before leaving, the homeowner showed me her shed door that was opened and how someone could climb onto her roof standing on the wooden shelves. The door is always closed according to her and she had found it opened in the morning with several items pushed out of the way. I looked at the shed and it is possible for someone to access her roof within a matter of seconds using the shelves from the shed to climb.

On Friday, October 28, 2021 at approximately 0243 hours, I (Ofc. Arguello) assisted with a foot pursuit, after a white male struck Ofc. Hansell.

Ofc. Wynn stated via radio that the individual was traveling towards Truman avenue. Ofc. Roscoe spotted the suspect in front of Don's place and ordered him to stop. The suspect began running East on Truman avenue. The suspect then ran North towards Watson Street and ran through the Bare assets (1029 Truman Avenue) parking lot heading East on Truman Avenue again. The Suspect then turn South on Varela Street towards the rear of The Bike Shop (1110 Truman Avenue). I ordered the suspect to stop, he refused. I struck the suspect in the facial area with my taser while he ran away from me. I deployed my agency issued taser but missed the suspect. The suspect then took off running South on Varela Street. We lost sight of the suspect at this point.

I placed my deployed cartridge into Key west Property for evidence. This incident was recorded on my BWC.

On 10/29/2021 at approximately 0243 hours, I was dispatched to Windsor Ln. and Watson Ln. for a battery call.

While enroute the description of the suspect was called out as a white male wearing black shorts and no shirt. When I arrived in the area I began to search for the suspect. The last location I had was headed on Windsor Ln. toward Truman Ave. I was headed east on Truman Ave when I spotted a male matching the description crossing Truman Ave. from Grinnell St. from north to south toward Don's Place (1000 Truman Ave.)

At this time, I exited my marked KWPD patrol car, wearing my KWPD uniform with KWPD insignias announced myself and told the male to stop. He continued to walk east on the sidewalk. I began to follow the male and again told him to stop. He then began to run east on the sidewalk.

At his time Ofc. Arguello arrived and tried to cut the suspect off using his patrol car, in front of Old Town Fitness (1010 Truman Ave.) We then chased the suspect across the street north on Watson Ln. where he cut back east through the Bare Assets (1029 Truman Ave.) parking lot then back east across the Truman Ave. to Varela St.

By this time Ofc. R. Perez had arrived and joined to assist in the pursuit. We chased the suspect to behind The Bike Shop (1110 Truman Ave.) the suspect then ran south on Varela St. where he cut through a yard at a private residence. I lost sight of the suspect at this time.

I then assisted in setting the perimeter so K-9 Ofc. Hansell and K-9 Ofc. Anglin could search the area using K-9 Dexter and K-9 Jigsaw.

My BWC did not activate to capture the above incident.

On 10/29/2021, at 0310 hours, I (Ofc. R. Perez) was looking for a battery suspect in the area of Truman and Windsor Ln.

While looking for the suspect I heard Ofc. Roscoe state he was with the suspect in front of Don's Place. I drove eastbound on Truman Ave. When I arrived in the area, I could see a white male, with spiked blonde hair, wearing short black shorts, mid-calf height white socks and white tennis shoes, running eastbound away from Ofc. Roscoe. I used my vehicle to block the path of the suspect. I pulled my vehicle in front of Old Town fitness and the suspect ran around my vehicle. He began to run northbound on Watson St. I waited in the parking lot of Bare Assets incase the suspect turned around and ran through the parking lot. The suspect turned around and ran across the Bare Assets parking lot. I cut him off and began to run after him. Ofc. Arguello and I chased the suspect east bound on Truman Ave. and he turned south on Varela St. The suspect ran into an open area next to the bike shop on Varela St. Ofc. Arguello attempted to grab the suspect but was unable to detain him. I drew my TASER, the suspect broke free from Ofc. Arguello, and I fired my TASER in the direction of the suspect. The subject continued to run and showed no signs of neuro muscular incapacitation. I reloaded my TASER while continuing to chase the suspect. The suspect ran south on Varela St. and jumped over a fence into 1014 Varela St.

Ofc. M. Hansell and K9 Dexter arrived on scene. I advised Ofc. M. Hansell the suspect ran into 1014 Varela St. They entered the property and I entered behind them. We cleared the property and were unable to find the suspect.

I was then advised by Sgt. Hammers to take a perimeter position on Watson and Virginia St. I held my post until I was advised by Sgt A. Rodriguez to break down the perimeter.

My AXON BWC was not activated during the foot chase but it was activated while I held a perimeter position and my used TASER cartridge will be placed in the KWPD Property and Evidence Division.

On November 10, 2021, I Detective M. del Valle was assigned the following case for further investigation. As per the original report taken by KWPD Officer Hansell while he was at the corner of Galveston Lane and Winsor Lane on October 29, 2021. An unknown male engaged himself and Officer Wynn in a physical fight.

The unknown suspect fled the scene fled east on Truman Avenue. Officer Arguello engaged the suspect at the 1000 block of Varela Street. The suspect was able to escape. Officer searched the area with but were not able to apprehend the suspect.

On October 30-2021, Officer Hansell was contacted by a homeowner at 1012 Varela St. unit # 3., who said she had shoes on her roof possibly left by the suspect. Officer Hansel met the homeowner at her residence, a single-story cottage to the North of 1014 Varela Street.

The homeowner told Officer Hansel that she had heard someone climbing on her roof a few minutes before KWPD Officer's began searching her yard on the night of the incident. Officer Hansel recovered the shoes and a gray sock using latex gloves. The shoes are white Nike men's Air Jordans size 11. The sock was a gray ankle sock.

On November 19, 2021 I spoke to KWPD Property Supervisor Megan Wilcox and confirmed that a FDLE request was filled. Wilcox confirmed that it was filled and that the shoes and sock were being sent to FDLE for DNA analysis. At this time this case is suspended pending the results from FDLE.
