-- Jesus Perez Arrest Narrative:

On November 12th, 2021, Officer Hartle and I responded to 1800 Atlantic Blvd Nature Preserve in reference to individuals possibly camping out in the mangroves. Officer Hartle and I began searching the mangroves and came across a makeshift campsite clearing area inside the mangroves.

We observed three individuals (later identified as a White female Yennilyn Vega DOB 09/04/1998, White male Jesus Perez DOB 12/01/1999 and White male Tiago Rodriguez DOB 01/04/2001) sitting near some wooden logs and ground of the mangroves. See body worn camera footage from both Officer Hartle and I body camera for further. Upon coming up to the encampment the female was talking to the other two males. In between them we observed tobacco leaves rolling paper from a cigar on top of the packaging in between Perez and Vega. On the wooden log to the right side of Perez was a cellular phone with green leafy substance on top of the screen. All three individuals noticed us in our patrol class B uniforms that are distinctly marked and designed. We then observed Perez attempt to conceal the green leafy substance with his right hand over the cellular phone.

Note Perez was wearing a blue backpack on his back and the cellular phone that had the green leafy substance on top of it was later claimed by Perez to be his property.

Due to my training and experience the strong odor of the green leafy substance was Marijuana.

Officer Hartle gave Perez clear loud verbal lawful commands to not touch the green leafy substance (Marijuana) with his hand. Perez disobeyed the direct order and proceeded to through the green leafy substance into the mangroves in front of him. While in the process of doing this he attempted to get up and run off away from us. Officer Hartle grabbed Perez by the arm and using a straight arm bar technique takedown brought Perez unto the ground. I then moved in and assisted in placing Perez in handcuffs. Perez was still wearing the back pack while being cuffed.

Officer Hartle began collecting the small round balls of green leafy substance (Marijuana) which was thrown by Perez. While searching the backpack incident to arrest we observed more green leafy substance along with items used for drug paraphernalia.

Note the other two (Vega and Tiago) were found to be in no possession of illegal narcotics and released with a trespass warning.

Officer Hartle field tested the green leafy substance located on the ground that was thrown by Perez, which resulted in a bright positive indication for Marijuana.

The evidence was collected along with the items from the back pack and processed securely at the Key West Police station by Officer Hartle. The evidence also field tested positive for Marijuana at the station. Officer Hartle provided me with the following information from the evidence collected:

- Total Marijuana: 181.8 grams
- RAW rolling papers
- A digital Scale
- Vape pens
- Gold ring

On duty supervisor Sergeant Pablo Rodriguez responded to the response to resistance that occurred with Perez attempting to flee.

Perez was transported to Monroe County Jail without incident. During my encounter either on the body worn camera or in the incar camera Perez spontaneously admitted to the Marijuana to being his and that he will "Own up to it as a man. That he ain`t no snitch, and it`s his personal (Marijuana) use."

Note: While at the Jail Perez spontaneously informed the intake Deputies (Deputy John Fox) that he was going to be in there for sometime and won`t be able to bond out, because he stated he had a half a pound of Marijuana, which was a felony amount.

Perez was charged with One count Possession of Marijuana with intent to sell within 200 feet of a public park (individual packaging "baggies" and digital scale only used to distribute and sell small quantities to others-Nature Preserve is a public park), One count Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (rolling papers and scale) and One count Resisting without Violence (attempting to flee and attempt to destroy evidence by throwing it away).

On Friday 11-12-2021, at about 12:04 pm, Officer Medina and Myself (Officer Hartle) were dispatched to The Nature Preserve City Park in reference to campers (1600 Atlantic). We walked the path from Atlantic Street to the beach. About 30 feet west of the stairway exit, there is a path leading into the trees. We entered this area and did hear voices as we approached. Undetected, we watched a female and male sitting on a towel and another male sitting on a log with his back to us. There was a cell phone sitting on the log next to the male with his back to us (By his right hand). On the glass face of the phone there were about 10 marble sized green buds that appeared to be marijuana. As we walked towards the area, the male slowly started to move his hand towards his phone. I told him not to touch it (twice) as he reached down and grabbed the phone. He then held the phone and threw the green buds up into the air and into the mangrove area. He then turned to his left and attempted to stand up and run. While he was standing up, I grabbed his back and re-directed him to the ground. Officer Medina and I secured him and Officer Medina placed handcuffs on the defendant (Identified by his Florida ID Card P620-420-99-441-0 as Jesus Perez. Perez also had a Department of Corrections ID also (0-180042).

About .7 grams of the green buds were found on the ground in the area where Perez threw them. They did field test positive for marijuana. Perez also had a backpack which contained several bags and a glass jar that contained these same green buds. They also field tested positive for marijuana. The total weight of this mamajuana found int backpack was about 181.8 grams. There was also 45 small yellow baggies (About 2x2 inches), a small battery operated scale, 3 boxes of electronic vapes, rolling papers, and a gold colored ring, and a small conch shell recovered from the backpack. Officer Standerwick and I processed this property and I turned it over to Officer Medina. My BWC was activated during the arrest of Perez and also showed the property.
