A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), AUTHORIZING A BRAND NAME SOLE SOURCE PURCHASING EXCEPTION, PURSUANT TO KEY WEST CODE OF ORDINANCES SEC. 2-843(a) AND 2-844(a) (BRAND NAME), AND 2-797(1)(c) (SOLE SOURCE), FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF FOUR (4) MODEL 900R PERISTALTIC "REMOTE" PUMP SYSTEMS FOR C,D,F & H DOCKS AT THE KEY WEST BIGHT MARINA FROM KECO PUMP AND EQUIPMENT (KECO) IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$89,761.15; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS AND ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Section 2-796 of the Code of Ordinances requires competitive bidding for purchases or services in excess of \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(1) permits the purchase of goods and services without competition on a sole source basis under certain specified conditions; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of KECO pumps pursuant to the brand name specifications provisions of Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-843 and 2-844 is permitted and recommended to ensure pump/mechanical continuity within the Key West Bight (and City Marina, and Key West Bight Ferry Terminal); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR

AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the expenditure of funds not to exceed \$89,761.15, to KECO Pump and Equipment is hereby approved on a brand name sole source basis pursuant to Key West Code of Ordinances sections 2-797(1)(c), 2-843(a)(4) and 2-844(a), for purchase of four (4) model 900R peristaltic "remote" pump systems for C,D,F & H docks at Key West Bight Marina.

Section 2: That funds for this purchase are budgeted in Infrastructure Fund account # 405-7503-575-6300 (Project No. KB75032203). A budget transfer in the amount of \$13,800.00 from Key West Bight reserves, and any necessary budget adjustments, are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute necessary documents upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect
