

Location: 80% (very visible tree-only one in front of this property growing next to sidewalk)

Species: 100% (on protected tree list)

Condition: 50% (overall condition is fair to poor, strong growth lean, canopy is one sided-lots of low branch growth over roadway, there might be an issue with root system but there is decking completely around tree so root system can not be properly evaluated at this time. Tree has the appearance of a recent strong lean toward street and sidewalk.) Total Average Value = 76%

Value x Diameter = 9.6 replacement caliper inches
