A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AND SUPPORTING DAILY PLAN-IT TO CONDUCT THE KEY WEST 200TH HERITAGE FESTIVAL AT KEY WEST TRUMAN WATERFRONT ON SATURDAY, MARCH 26th, 2022 FROM 10:00 A.M. TO 9:00 P.M. (BREAK DOWN SUNDAY, MARCH 27, 2022); PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Daily Plan-it wishes to conduct the Key West 200th Heritage Festival at the Key West Truman Waterfront Park on Saturday, March 26, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

WHEREAS, the City of Key West supports the Key West 200th Heritage Festival and recognizes the need to use the Key West Truman Waterfront for numerous events throughout the day including booths, stage for entertainment, Pirates, wreckers, sponges, fishing, Bahamians, Civil War Art & Entertainment, children's fun areas, drone show and many other fun events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West Florida;

SECTION 1. That In Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law"

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are

neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City"

SECTION 3. Daily Plan-It is hereby granted permission to conduct the Key West 200th Heritage Festival on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and that organization meets the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Daily Plan-it. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That Daily Plan-It must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. That the Daily Plan-It will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, and that (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by this Commission, or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID-19 in the Community.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
