On 12/27/2021, at 2212 hours, I (Ofc. R. Perez) was on foot patrol on the 200 block of Duval St.

I notice a verbal argument between a bouncer and a patron at Rick's Bar. I walk toward the argument to try to diffuse the situation. I then notice a male later identified by his Virginia DL as Collin Gantt shove a male later identified by his Florida DL as Max Rodriguez. Gantt then rears back to throw a punch at Rodriguez. I grab Gantt around the waist and perform a modified rear leg sweep to prevent him from striking Rodriguez. Gantt and I end up on the ground and I start to give Gantt loud verbal commands to place his hands behind his back. Gantt looks at me and began to pull his arms away from me to avoid being placed in handcuffs. Ofc. Agleev arrived on scene and attempted to take control of Gantt's left hand. Gantt continued to pull his hands away and try to avoid arrest. We finally take control of Gantt's hands and place him in handcuffs. Gantt was searched and placed in the back seat of Ofc. Agleev's patrol vehicle.

I walk over to Rodriguez and asked what had occurred. Rodriguez stated the had kicked Gantt out of the bar earlier on in the night and told him he could not return. Gantt walked into the karaoke bar and was escorted out by Rodriguez. Gantt continued to try to enter, and Rodriguez held his hand out to stop Gantt from approaching him. Gantt then shoved him, threw a punch and that was when I stepped in. I asked Rodriguez if he would like to press charges against Gantt and he initially stated no. I was later advised by Ofc. Agleev that Rodriguez did want to press charges. (See Ofc. Agleev's supplemental report).

Ofc. Agleev also advised me that the manager of Rick's Bar approached him and wanted to press charges against Gantt for trespassing.

I placed Gantt in the back seat of my patrol vehicle and transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center. While in route Gantt proceeded to call me racial and homophobic slurs. Upon arrival to MCDC Gantt was turned away due to him having a fever. I then transported Gantt to Lower Keys Medical Center. When we arrived, we were told by the medical staff to wait outside and we will be seen when they had an open bed. Gantt began to hit his head against the partition in my patrol vehicle. I Gave Gantt several commands to stop and he continued to hit his head. Gantt was removed from my patrol vehicle by myself and Monroe County Sherriff's Office Sgt. B. Williams. He was placed in a seat outside the emergency room door to stop him from hitting his head.

Gantt was later admitted to the emergency room and he was placed in room two. While in the room I had to continually tell Gantt to sit down and to stop getting up. At one point Gantt got up approached me in an aggressive manner and said, "no what are you gonna do about it." I placed Gantt on the hospital bed and hobbled his legs together to stop him from approaching me in an aggressive manner. Gantt was later medically cleared.

I then transported Gantt back to MCDC. Upon arrival he refused to listen to commands given to him by Detention Deputies and called the jail staff racial slurs. Gantt was placed in a restrained chair and then placed in a holding cell.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 12/27/2021, Collin Gantt did knowingly and intentionally shove Max Rodriguez against his will violating F.S.S. 784.03(1)(a)(1) Battery touch or strike.

Furthermore, Collin Gantt did resist Ofc. Agleev and I's commands to place his hands behind his back, pulling his hands away and not allowing us to lawfully execute our legal duty of detaining him violating F.S.S. 843.02 Resist officer without violence.

On December 27, 2021 at approximately 2212 hours I, Officer D. Agleev, responded to 202 Duval Street (Rick's Bar), reference a physical disturbance.

Upon arrival I observed Officer R. Perez and Rick's security personnel holding on the ground a white male, later identified as Collin Gantt (Arrestee). Officer Perez told me, Gantt was fighting the security guards and had to be taken down. Officer Perez and I handcuffed Gantt behind the back and placed him in the back of my patrol vehicle.

Sergeant Sims responded to scene, reference a Response to Resistance Incident, and spoke to Gantt. Following the investigation, Gantt was relocated to Officer Perez's vehicle and transported to the Monroe County Detention Center (see Officer Perez's Arrest Affidavit).

I talked to Rick's security guard Max Rodriguez (Victim), who told me the following: Highly intoxicated Gantt was refused service at Rick's earlier that night and went to Sloppy Joe's Bar across the street. Gantt got trespassed from Sloppy Joe's and tried to get back inside Rick's. Rodriguez stood in front of Gantt blocking entrance to Rick's, and advised him to leave. Gantt did not like that and pushed Rodriguez, starting a fight. Rodriguez wanted to press charges for battery.

Rick's security supervisor Ray responded to scene and told me, the management wanted to press trespass charges against Gantt, since he kept coming back after multiple warnings.

I forwarded Rodriguez's info and statement to Officer Perez.

My BWC and Fleet In Car were activated for this incident.
