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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, TO APPROVE THE RANKING OF RESPONSES TO THE REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) NO. 22-002 FOR THE SUNSET CELEBRATION/ MALLORY SQUARE MASTER PLAN BY THE SELECTION COMMITTEE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO DRAFT A CONTRACT WITH THE HIGHEST RANKING FIRM OR TEAM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No.22-002 to identify a vendor to develop a master plan for the Sunset Celebration/Mallory Square area, as set forth in RFQ No. 22-002; and

WHEREAS, the RFQ outlines the professional services required to complete this project, and requires deliverables including partial construction drawings; and

WHEREAS, the City intends for its vendor to continue to incorporate public input throughout this design process; and

WHEREAS, Mallory Square was identified in the Key West Forward Strategic Plan as one of the highest ranked priority capital improvement projects for the City of Key West; and

WHEREAS, on February 2, 2022, the City Clerk opened vendor submittals, all of which were deemed responsive; and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2022, a Selection/Ranking Committee comprised of community members and City staff ranked the RFQ submittals; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the vendor submittals to RFQ No.22-002 for the Sunset Celebration/Mallory Square Master Plan are hereby ranked by the Selection Committee, and approved by the City Commission as follows:

- (1) Sasaki with 85 points
- (2) GAI Consultants with 77.5 points
- (3) AE7 with 73.5 points
- (4) KEITH with 71 points
- (5) K2M with 69.75 points (tied with 6)
- (6) Chen Moore & Associates with 69.75 points (tied with 5)
- (7) S&ME, Inc. with 68.75 points
- (8) BEA Architects with 66 points

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute regulatory agreements with the top-ranked vendor, Sasaki, in substantial conformance with the RFQ, and as legally permissible pursuant to the City Charter, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.
