Interconnected Vehicles

\$5.2M Keys COAST county-wide pilot to improve safety and reduce congestion

- As many as 63 City vehicles (Police, Fire, Transit, and more) will be participating
- Equipment Installation to begin as early as August

Mobility Study

Measure all Recreational Rental Vehicle effects on safety.

Quantify nuisance levels: traffic, noise, pollution

- Study originally set to be complete by Summer 2022
- Request for Quote to be advertised 3/18
- City Commission may make a selection June 7th (tentative)

Project Funding

Transportation Alternative grant was submitted for Wickers Realignment

- Construction cost now expected \$683k

Infrastructure Type Project Updates

- Wickers Realignment
 - Seeking workable alternative for all stakeholders
 - City, County, Housing Authority
- Salt Ponds Trails
 - Change in ownership expected due to airport expansion
- 1st Street and Bertha
 - Atlantic and Bertha is being evaluated to determine stop control
 - Expected completion Summer 2022
- United Street
 - Design alternative to consider one-way conversion and bicycle facilities (mid-March)
