-- Victoria Louise Cantrell Arrest Narrative:

On Thursday January 27, 2022, at about 1341 Hours, Officer Thomas Stutz, Trainee Officer Roy Owens, and I (Officer Janeth Del Cid) responded to 1317 Reynolds Street, in reference to a possible violation of injunction.

The caller, Ellen Cantrell stated her daughter Victoria Cantrell was at the residence trespassing after haven been issued a temporary injunction 2016DP84K, on January 11, 2022. The temporary injunction is for Cantrell not to have contact with her children. The children were not on scene and the injunction does not include the mother. Upon arrival, I noticed Officer T. Stutz was near the intersection of Reynolds and South Street, speaking with a female, later identified as Victoria Cantrell. Officer Owens and I activated our Body Worn Camera (BWC) and approached Officer Stutz and the female.

I could hear the female refusing to cooperate with Officer Stutz, when she saw me and Officer Owens, she proceeded to quickly get up and attempted to leave, at which point, Officer Stutz tried to detain Cantrell, but she active physically resisted by tensing up and pulling, therefore Officer Owens assisted Officer Stutz and redirected Cantrell to the ground, where she was handcuffed and detained for resisting without violence.

Officer Owens conducted a search of Cantrell's purse and located a pouch containing a clear baggie of a white crystal-like powdery substance. A Field test of the substance tested positive for methamphetamine, weighing .9 grams.

While on scene, Rescue Paramedics responded on scene and checked Cantrell for any signs of injury. None were noted. Victoria Cantrell was arrested for resisting an officer without violence, which is in violation of Florida State Statute 843.02 and Possession of a Controlled Substance, methamphetamine, which is in violation of Florida State Statute 893.13 6 (a). Cantrell was transported to Monroe County Jail without incident.

On Thursday, January 27, 2022 at approximately 1340 hours, Ofc. Owens, Ofc. Del Cid, Ofc. Revoredo and I (Ofc. Stutz) responded to 1317 Reynolds Street for a report of a Court Order Violation.

On arrival, Ofc. Revoredo and I were flagged down by the reporting person, Ellen Cantrell. Ellen advised her daughter, Victoria Cantrell, came to her residence and was acting unstable. Ellen advised Victoria has had issues in the past and currently Ellen has custody of Victoria's children. Ellen advised the children were not present at the time of this incident. Ellen advised due to Victoria's past history of instability she contacted the Key West Police Department. Ellen stated as she tried to speak with dispatchers Victoria began screaming and tried to grab the telephone from her. Ellen stated Victoria fled North on Reynolds St. toward United St. as we arrived in the area. Ellen stated Victoria was wearing a blue dress and a pink sweatshirt.

Ofc. Revoredo spoke with Ellen and I attempted to locate Victoria. I observed an older male pointing toward a large tree in a yard at the corner of United St. and Seminary St. I approached the area and saw Victoria laying in between two large roots of the tree. I advised Victoria I was with the Key West Police Department and asked her what was going on. Victoria began rambling statements like " my father is a powerful man he tortured me ... he work's for Elon Musk ... He owns the police." Victoria's statements were not coherent and had little basis in the reason we were called to respond. I asked Victoria her name. Victoria initially refused to tell me but eventually gave me her name. I asked Victoria about why she had come to her mother's house and to explain about the alleged Court Order.

As I asked the question, Ofc. Del Cid and Ofc. Owens arrived on scene. When Ofc. Del Cid and Ofc. Owens approached, Victoria stood and tried to flee. I grabbed Victoria's left wrist and advised her she was not free to leave as the investigation was not over. Victoria began screaming and tried to pull away. Ofc. Owens grabbed Victoria's right arm as she continued to try to pull away. I performed a bent wrist takedown and placed Victoria on the ground. Victoria attempted to pull her arms beneath her in an attempt to prevent herself from being handcuffed. I pulled Victoria's arm behind her back and placed her in handcuffs, double locked. Victoria was placed in a seated position and spoke to Ofc. Del Cid and Ofc. Owens.

I then met with Ofc. Revoredo in reference to the incident. Ofc. Revoredo relayed the abovementioned information provided by Ellen.

I requested Sgt. P. Rodriguez respond to the scene reference a response to resistance incident. I also requested Key West Fire Rescue respond to the scene as Victoria was complaining of injury. Victoria had no visible physical injuries but was complaining of soreness in her arms due to the takedown. Sgt. P. Rodriguez arrived on scene and I briefed him about the incident.

Ofc. Del Cid later informed me that Victoria was in possession of a large fixed blade knife and a baggie containing a white, crystal, type substance (FTP Methamphetamine). Ofc. Del Cid and Ofc. Owens took custody of Victoria and
