#### -- Amber Rose Gunhus Arrest Narrative:

On Saturday January 29, 2022, at about 0048 hours, Ofc. D. Agleev and I, (Ofc. L. Hernandez), were dispatched to 801 Duval Street (801 Bourbon Bar), in reference to a female that was being asked to leave the premises and she kept refusing and kept returning.

Upon arrival, Ofc. Agleev and I made contact with the female, later identified as Amber Rose Gunhus (DOB 08/25/1982) (Arrestee). Amber was evidently under the influence of alcoholic intoxicant (s) as per her slurred slow speech, glassy and watery eyes, flushed and red face, strong odor of alcoholic beverage (s) emanating from her breath and disorderly behavior.

Amber was found inside the establishment sitting in the bar area when we arrived. A male named Henry Urey (DOB 04/28/1965) (Reporting party), told Ofc. Agleev, Amber was asked to leave multiple times, she left but came back and sat at the bar. Ofc. Agleev escorted Amber outside and stood on the Petronia Street side of the establishment. Amber was identified by her Florida driver's license and told she was being issued a trespass warning by request of the establishment. Amber kept arguing and talking over us while we were explaining that the establishment wished for her to be trespassed. Amber kept saying "why, I am going to talk to my lawyer because they can not do that". We explained to Amber that she may contact her lawyer whenever she desires but that we only needed her to leave the establishment and that she was free to go. We informed Amber multiple times she was being trespassed from the establishment and that if she returned, she would be subject to arrest. Amber was argumentative and would not understand she was not welcomed at this establishment.

Donald Merle Deihl (DOB 05/16/1980) (Witness), was the bartender that was working behind the bar when Amber was at the bar being asked to leave and also when she was being arrested. Deihl completed a sworn written statement that elaborates on the details including the times Amber was asked to leave and she refused.

Amber followed Ofc. Agleev to his patrol vehicle as we were getting ready to leave. I had to asked Amber to get off the road as she was blocking the flow of traffic. Amber was standing in the middle of Petronia Street as vehicles were trying to drive by. Amber moved to the North side of Petronia near my patrol vehicle and while I was getting ready to leave, she started walking in a fast pace towards the establishment and made entry. I followed Amber inside and to catch up to her I had to walk faster as she started to almost run inside the bar towards the rear. I caught up to her and I grabbed her right arm. Amber freed herself from my grab by pulling away. I told Amber to stop and turn around and to place her hands behind her back. Amber resisted by trying to again walk away, I managed to get a hold of her shoulders and again I told her to stop, and she kept trying to defeat my lawful attempts of placing her under arrest. I hip tossed her in a control manner and brought her to the ground. As I brought Amber to the ground the back of her head struck a concrete step causing a laceration to the back of her head approximately 2/3 inches in length. Amber began to bleed, I radioed Key West Dispatch and requested a Key West Fire Rescue unit respond to provide medical services.

As I was trying to place handcuffs on Amber, she kept resisting by tensing up and tried to fold her left arm into her abdomen. I told Amber to stop resisting and to free her arm and let go her cellphone and pocketbook she kept holding tight with her left hand. Ofc. Agleev assisted me in placing her in handcuffs, I checked them for tightness and double locked them. We escorted Amber outside where Key West Fire Rescue 2 arrived on scene and provided medical services to Amber. Amber was cleared by Rescue 2 for transport. Sgt. A. Rodriguez arrived on scene and met with Amber reference the response to resistance incident. I transported Amber to Lower Keys Medical Center Emergency Room where she was treated for her head injury and medically cleared by ER staff and on duty doctor. I transported

Amber to the Monroe County Detention Center where she was turned over to Detention Deputies without further issues.

Amber displayed an active level of resistance that consisted of pulling away from me when I tried to make a lawful arrest and then tensing up while Ofc. Agleev and I kept repeatedly ordering her to stop resisting. I believe the use of force to detain Amber, for our safety and hers, including the totally of circumstances, and the level of resistance she was displaying was necessary to control the situation and to safely make the lawful arrest. Ofc. Agleev and I were wearing Key West Police issued Class B uniforms and agency insignias and badges that clearly identifies us as law enforcement officers during the entire encounter with Amber.

Based on all evidence and the totality of circumstances, I believe Amber committed the misdemeanor criminal offense of trespassing by failing to leave the premises by order of the property owner or authorized agent. Amber willfully entered the premises after being asked to leave by staff, defied the order and after being warned by us she willfully entered the premises in violation of F.S. 810.09(2B).

Based on all evidence and the totality of circumstances, I believe Amber committed the misdemeanor criminal offense of resisting arrest without violence by pulling away from me when I was trying to detain her and make a lawful arrest and by tensing up her arms as I was trying to place handcuffs on her in violation of F.S. 843.02.

My BWC and Axon Fleet (3452) were both activated during this incident.

End of report. Cleared by arrest.
