-- Terence Neilly Arrest Narrative:

On 02/05/2022, around 21:37 hours, I (Ofc Bozzetti) was dispatched to 3444 N Roosevelt Blvd, The Laureate, reference a male refusing to leave the property.

On arrival, I observed an older male, later identified as Terence Neilly, asleep on a couch inside the hotel lobby. The front desk employee, later identified as Tasrine Brown, stated Neilly did not have a reservation and became extremely rude when asked to leave. I woke Neilly up and explained that he needed to leave the property. He became argumentative, said he was not going to leave and that he was going to hit me in the balls. I asked him one more time to leave on his own accord, or I would be forced to arrest him. Neilly postured up, while remaining seated on the couch, and stated he was not leaving. I reached for his left arm, and he pulled away and began actively resisting me. I gained control of his left arm and escorted him to the ground using a modified straight arm takedown. K-9 Ofc. Hansell arrived as soon as the subject was taken to the ground and assisted me with gaining control of Neilly. I placed him into handcuffs and escorted him to my patrol car.

Sgt. Kouri arrived on scene and documented the RRI. Neilly had a very small abrasion above his left eye, however, he stated it was an old injury.

I transported Neilly to the MCDC. He was brought upstairs to be seen by the MCDC nurse. The nurse stated he had an old cut on the top of his head that re-opened and would not stop bleeding. I transported Neilly to the LKMC for medical clearance. At the hospital Neilly refused to answer any questions and began yelling at the staff. Neilly began to stand up from his seat and I told him to sit back down and started to assist him in sitting back down in his seat. Without warning, Neilly performed a surprisingly quick front kick with his right leg, striking me in the left kneecap. I grabbed Neilly and placed him back on the bed and waited until he was done trying to fight me. Neilly apologized and said he was done kicking. I repositioned Neilly into a seated position on the bed. I was uninjured from the kick. Since I was inside the hospital, my BWC was not activated for the kick.

The doctor provided me with refusal paperwork, and I transported Neilly back to the MCDC to be booked.

Since Neilly refused to leave The Laureate's property after order by an authorized person, he was in violation of F.S.S. 810.09-2B.

Since Neilly resisted an officer in the legal execution of their duties, he was in violation of F.S.S. 843.02.

My BWC and In-Car AXON were activated during all encounters with Neilly, except for inside the hospital.
