Measure all Recreational Rental Vehicle effects on safety.

Quantify nuisance levels: traffic, noise, pollution

- Request for Qualifications for a Recreational Rental Vehicle Impact Analysis released 3/30
- City Commission may make a selection June 21st (tentative)

RRV insurance requirements expected to be lowered (Second reading 5/03)

Project Funding

Transportation Alternative grant was submitted for Wickers Realignment

- Construction cost now expected \$683k
- Project ranked highest by Monroe County among TA projects

- FHWA funds encumbered - going to bid this Summer
