On Sunday April 3, 2022, at about 336 hours, I, (Ofc. L. Hernandez) and Ofc. S. Adorno, were dispatched to 202 Duval Street (Ricks Bar), reference a theft incident.

Upon arrival, I met with Jason David Walck (DOB 06/16/1980) (witness), who is one of the managers at Ricks. Jason, Ofc. Adorno and I headed to the office to review the surveillance video that depicts the theft taking place. As we were walking into Rick's office, bouncers that were working the front stairs that lead to the upstairs of Rick's radioed Jason letting him know the theft suspect was trying to get back into the complex. The male suspect was later identified as Angel Martin Meza (DOB 02/07/1995) (Arrestee), identified by his Florida ID card.

Ofc. Adorno and I arrived at the front steps of the entrance to the complex and found Angel being held down by Rick's bouncers. I stepped in and grabbed Angel by his arms and pulled him away from the entrance way and away from the crowds. As I was pulling Angel away, I identified myself as a Key West Police Officer and I gave him clear and loud commands to get down on the ground. Angel would not comply, and Angel resisted by tensing up and tried to walk away from us as I was holding him by his right arm. I ordered Angel to get down on the ground again and he did not comply. I hip tossed Angel to the ground in a control manner with the assistance of Ofc. Adorno and we placed him in handcuffs, checked them for tightness and double locked them. Both, Ofc. Adorno and I were wearing Key West Police Department issued Class B uniforms which clearly identifies us as law enforcement officers. I conducted a search incident to arrest of Angel and placed him in the rear of my patrol vehicle. I requested Sgt. JT. Conaty respond to the scene to complete a response to resistance investigation. Sgt. Conaty arrived on scene and obtained the required information for the RRI. Angel did not sustained injuries that required medical attention during his arrest. I asked Angel if he wanted medical attention for his scrapped right knee and scuffed left side of his forehead and he declined.

I read Angel his Miranda Rights from an agency issued card. Angel invoked his rights. Ofc. Adorno watched the video provided by Rick's. The victim, later identified as Andrew Grant Laubach (DOB 12/15/1992), identified by his California driver's license was sitting at the bar upstairs facing the dance floor. The video shows Andrew placing his wallet on the bar's counter. The video depicts Angel grabbing Andrew's wallet, walking away with it then it shows Angel going through the wallet at The Mardy Gra Bar and then tossing it. Video shows Angel removing some of the contents and then walking away. The wallet was later retrieved by Rick's staff near a trash can upstairs. Andrew said he was missing \$120 US dollars in cash and an American Express Card from his wallet when it was returned to him.

Ofc. R. Ham arrived on scene, provided scene safety and obtained witness statement.

I transported Angel to the Monroe County Detention Center where he was turned over to Detention Deputies without issues.

Based on all facts, evidence, and totality of circumstances, I believe Angel committed the misdemeanor criminal offense of petit theft as defined in FSS 812.014 - Theft - Angel knowingly took Andrew's wallet, removed the cash and credit card with the intent to, either temporarily or permanently deprive Andrew of the right to his property.

Based on all facts, evidence, and totality of circumstances, I believe Angel committed the misdemeanor criminal offense of resisting an officer without violence to his / her person as defined in FSS 843.02 - Angel actively resisted by tensing up and trying to walk away as we gave him clear and loud commands to comply. I believe due to Angel's level of resistance and the totality of circumstances we had to use the level of force necessary to control the situation, to protect Angel, the general public and ourselves.

My BWC and Axon Fleet (3452) were both activated during this incident. The video depicting the crime of theft was

On April 3, 2022, at approximately 0341 hours, Ofc. Hernandez and I (Ofc. Adorno) responded to 202 Duval St (Ricks) in reference to a theft.

Upon arrival, I immediately witnessed two individuals in a scuffle on the stairs entrance to Ricks. I could see a Ricks bouncer holding down Angel. Ofc. Hernandez and I grabbed Angel and pulled him away from the entrance. As Angel was being pulled away, Ofc. Hernandez and I identified ourselves as Key West Police Officers and gave Angel clear and loud commands to get on the ground. Angel did not reply and resisted by tensing up and walking away. Ofc. Hernandez then hip tossed Angel in a controlled manner as I assisted him to the ground. Angel was then placed into handcuffs, checked for tightness and double locked them. Meza was walked over to Ofc. Hernandez's patrol vehicle, searched incident to arrest and placed in the rear of the patrol vehicle.

I followed up with the manager of Rick's for video footage. The video begins with Meza at the bar closest to the dance floor. You can see the victim then begin to look for the wallet that was on top of the table. Meza grabs the wallet and walks toward another bar (Mardi Gras View) looks into the wallet, takes the American Express card and dumps the wallet by the bar table. The video continues with Rick's staff stopping him and talking to him.

Ricks provided a CD with the footage of the theft. The CD was submitted into property and evidence.

I followed up with a witness, identified as Jason Walck, who is another employee at Ricks. Walck was given a witness statement form and told to write down a brief summary of the incident. The witness statement was filled completely and placed into records.

My BWC was activated for the incident.
