On April 27, 2022, at approximately 2355 hours, I (Ofc. Waite) was dispatched to 3140 Northside Drive as back up for Ofc. R. Perez who was investigating a driver that was slumped over the wheel of a pick-up truck. While enroute, Ofc. Perez advised over Key West Communications Channel 1 that the subject was fighting him and attempting to drive away. Upon hearing the transmission, I expedited my response to Ofc. Perez's location.

On arrival, I observed Ofc. Perez standing near the driver's side door of a 2019 red Chevrolet Silverado (FL Tag 45BMPQ). Ofc. Perez was in a physical struggle with the driver, identified later as Edwin Antonio Parada Chavez. I parked my patrol vehicle and immediately approached the driver's side door. While struggling to remove Edwin from the vehicle, Ofc. Perez told me he was bit on the arm. I grabbed a hold of Edwin and attempted to pull him out of the vehicle. Edwin actively resisted our attempts by pulling away from Ofc. Perez and I. Due to Edwin's resistance, I unholstered my TASER and delivered a drive stun into his back. During the cycle, Ofc. Perez and I were able to fully extract Edwin from the vehicle. Ofc. Perez and I immediately took Edwin to the ground, in a controlled manner, to limit his movement. On the ground, Edwin placed his left hand under his chest to avoid being placed in handcuffs. Ofc. Perez and I issued Edwin several commands, in both English and Spanish, to place his hands behind his back. Edwin refused. Utilizing the drive stun technique, I delivered several cycles into various areas of Edwin's back to achieve compliance. Once in handcuffs, I placed a hobble device around both of Edwin's legs to limit any further movement.

Ofc. Perez showed me the bight mark on his left forearm. I observed a red discoloration surrounded by two opposing u-shaped arches with visible tooth impressions. I notified Key West Communications Channel One of Ofc. R. Perez's injury. I also advised that Edwin had been drive stunned in response to his resistance.

I spoke with Ofc. Perez who told me he was on routine patrol on 14th Street, in his marked patrol vehicle, when he observed Edwin asleep behind the wheel of his pickup truck. Ofc. Perez advised the driver's side door was open and Edwin was slumped over the center console. Ofc. Perez told me he approached the vehicle and attempted to rouse Edwin by gently pushing his shoulder. Ofc. Perez stated Edwin woke up and looked directly at him. At the time, Ofc. Perez was wearing his full KWPD Class B uniform, duty belt, firearm, and badge. Ofc. Perez stated Edwin began speaking with him at which point he observed several indicators of impairment, i.e., bloodshot glassy eyes and slurred unintelligible speech. While speaking, Ofc. Perez stated that Edwin attempted to close the driver's side door. To prevent him from driving away, Ofc. Perez stated he grabbed Edwin by the arm and asked him to step out of the vehicle. Ofc. Perez stated Edwin pulled away from him and tried to close the door, striking him in the process. Ofc. Perez stated he attempted to extract Edwin from the vehicle while issuing loud verbal commands in both English and Spanish. Ofc. Perez stated Edwin responded, "never" while making physically evasive movements to defeat his attempts of control. During the struggle, Ofc. Perez told me Edwin bit him several times on his left forearm, Ofc. R. Perez stated he told Edwin to stop biting him however he continued to clamp down on his arm, refusing to release his grasp. Ofc. Perez stated he delivered a knee strike to Edwin's right arm in an attempt to free himself. Ofc. Perez stated Edwin grabbed his genitalia and began to squeeze. Ofc. Perez stated when he commanded Edwin to release his genitalia, he laughed. For further information see Ofc. Perez's supplemental report.

Key West Rescue 1 responded to our location to evaluate Ofc. Perez and Edwin. Edwin was cleared by Rescue 1 with no medical need. Ofc. R. Perez later responded to Lower Keys Medical Center and received a tetanus shot to prevent and/or aid against infection.

I secured Edwin in the rear of my patrol vehicle and transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident.

My BWC and in-car recording system were activated during this incident.

Based on the facts and evidence, Edwin Antonio Parada Chavez did knowingly and willfully resist, obstruct, and oppose Ofc. R. Perez with violence contrary to F.S. 843.01 - Resist Officer with Violence. In doing so, Edwin Antonio Parada Chavez did actually and intentionally, strike Ofc. Perez with a door, bite Ofc. Perez's left forearm, and grab Ofc. Perez's genitalia against his will contrary to F.S. 784.07-2B - Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer. At the time, Ofc. Perez was wearing his full KWPD Class B uniform, full duty belt, badge, and firearm.

On 04/27/2022, at 2355 hours, I (Ofc. R. Perez) was on routine patrol of 14th St. when I noticed a red Chevrolet pickup truck bearing Florida tag 45BMPQ in a parking lot, with the driver of the vehicle asleep at the wheel.

I approach the vehicle and noticed a male later identified by his Florida DL as Edwin Parada-Chavez slumped over his center console asleep. I tried waking up Parada-Chavez verbally and he did not respond. I then placed my arm on Parada-Chavez's left shoulder and pushed him gently trying to wake him up. Parada-Chavez woke up, looked at me and began to speak. I was wearing my class B Key West Police Depatment uniform. Parada-Chavez's words were unintelligible and slurred. Parada-Chavez's eyes were bloodshot and glossy. I asked Parada-Chavez to step out of the vehicle because he was showing signs of impairment. I did not want Parada-Chavez to drive away and possible harm himself or others. He began to speak, and he attempted to close his car door. I grabbed Parada-Chavez's wrist and told him to step out of the vehicle in both English and Spanish. Parada-Chavez pulled away and tried to close the door, striking me with the door. I began to try to remove Parada-Chavez out of the car and he kept pulling away. I gave Parada-Chavez loud verbal commands in both English and Spanish to get out of the car. Parada-Chavez at one point said "never." Parada-Chavez leaned out of the vehicle, and I wrapped my arms around his upper body trying to pry him out of the vehicle. He then bit me several times on my left forearm. I gave him loud verbal commands to stop biting me. Parada-Chavez bit and did not release my arm. I delivered a knee strike to Parada-Chavez's right bicep to have him release the bite. Parada-Chavez then grabbed my genitals on the outside of my pants and began to squeeze. I yelled at him to let go of my genitals and he began to laugh.

Ofc. Waite arrived on scene and assisted me in removing Parada-Chavez out of his vehicle. We got Parada-Chavez on the ground in the prone position and alternated giving loud verbal commands to put his hands behind his back in both English and Spanish. Parada-Chavez continued to tense up and pull away as we tried to place him in handcuffs. Parada-Chavez was handcuffed and hobbled then placed in the recovery position.

Rescue 3 arrived on scene and cleaned up the area where I was bit. I then drove to Lower Keys Medical to be treated for the bite.

My AXON BWC was activated during this incident.
