-- Kathryn Marie Lemoine Arrest Narrative:

On Saturday May 14, 2022, at about 1743 hours, I, (Ofc. L. Hernandez), was dispatched to the corner of Stevens and Atlantic Avenue, in reference to a male and female having sex, doing drugs, being drunk, and arguing.

Upon arrival, I met with the male and female, who were sitting on one of the planters next to 1500 Atlantic Boulevard. The male was later identified as Robert William Scott Browning (DOB 11/10/1957) and the female as Kathryn Marie Lemoine (DOB 05/20/1979) (Arrestee). Browning and Lemoine were sitting next to each other and kissing. Their belongings, such as bicycles, bags, and shoes, were spread out on the bike path. Both were under the influence of alcoholic intoxicants as per their slurred speech, blood shot glassy and droopy eyes and strong smell of alcoholic beverage (s) emanating from their breath and body. I started to question Lemoine and Browning by asking them what they were doing. They said, "we are just sitting here". Soon after, Ofc. R. Ham arrived on scene to provide backup assistance. I asked both to provide identification and Browning provided his Florida ID card. Lemoine said she did not have identification. I asked Lemoine to provide her full name. Lemoine gave me the name of Dharma Weaber. I asked Lemoine multiple times to spell her first name, middle and last and she would repeat the name Dharma as being her first name. Lemoine began to get belligerent, she said, "fuck you" and then screamed from the top of her lungs incoherently. Lemoine began to stand and raised her arms, walking towards Ofc. Ham and I in an attacking manner while screaming. I gave Lemoine loud and cleared lawful commands to calm down and she kept charging towards us. As I am trying to detain Lemoine by grabbing her arms, she swung her left elbow hitting me on my chest and knocking down my body worn camera. I perceived the situation escalating as Lemoine was not complying with our lawful loud and cleared commands asking her to stop resisting. To take control of the situation, to prevent harm to us and to Lemoine I took her down to the ground in a control manner with the assistance of Ofc. Ham with a leg sweep. Lemoine kept resisting as we were trying to place her in handcuffs by pulling away and tensing up. Ofc. Ham and I gained control of Lemoine and placed her in handcuffs, checked them for tightness and double locked them. Ofc. J. Lopez arrived on scene and assisted us. Lemoine tried to use her legs to defeat our attempts of placing her in custody. Lemoine raised both of her legs towards Ofc. Lopez. A hobble had to be used to restrain Lemoine's legs and to prevent her from harming us. Lemoine sustained scrapes on her face and feet from the take down. Once we had full control of Lemoine I requested Key West Fire Rescue to respond to treat Lemoine for her minor injuries and for my supervisor to respond to the scene to conduct a response to resistance investigation. Key West Fire Rescue 1 arrived on scene, and we helped them place Lemoine in their stretcher. Lemoine kept screaming from the top of her lungs as she was being placed into the ambulance. My supervisor Sgt. D. Kouri arrived on scene and completed the response to resistance investigation. I believe the level of force used to control the volatile situation was reasonable and necessary. Lemoine refused to listen to multiple lawful commands from Ofc. Ham and myself.

Browning was asked for how long and how he met Lemoine, and he said he just met her while riding his bicycle in the area today and decided to sit down with her. Browning had some preexisting lacerations to the left side of his neck. I asked him multiple times how he sustained the injuries to his neck, and he would not respond. Browning was eventually informed he was free to go and left the scene.

Key West Fire Rescue 2 transported Lemoine to the Lower Keys Medical Center Emergency Room. Ofc. Ham rode with Rescue 2 to assist as Lemoine's level of resistance was still aggressive. I arrived at the LKMC Emergency Room and met with the medical staff who was treating Lemoine. When the doctor on duty tried to assess Lemoine she tried biting him. Lemoine had to be held down by hospital security and myself through the whole time she was being treated for her minor injuries. Lemoine mood and behavior kept changing. She would lay down on the bed but

at times would try to get up and when told to calm down and lay down she would try to bite staff. Lemoine was eventually given medical clearance by the doctor. I transported Lemoine to the Monroe County Detention Center. At arrival at the jail, Lemoine began to behave belligerent again, she had to be held down by the Deputies and myself, as she kept trying to pull away from us and screaming from the top of her lungs. Lemoine would not comply and would not cease screaming. Due to her level of resistance and to prevent her for harming us and or herself the jail staff decided to place Lemoine in the restrain chair.

Based on all evidence, facts, and totality of circumstances, I believe I have probable cause Lemoine committed the felony criminal offense of battery on law enforcement officer as described in FSS 784.07 (2) (B). I informed Lemoine upon contacting her I was a police officer. During my encounter with Lemoine I was wearing my Key West Police Department issued Class B uniform which clearly identifies me as a law enforcement officer. Lemoine made attacking movements towards me and Ofc. Ham. Lemoine struck me on my chest with her left arm.

Based on all evidence, facts, and totality of circumstances, I believe I have probable cause Lemoine committed the felony criminal offense of resisting arrest with violence as described in FSS 843.01 - Lemoine made physical evasive and attacking movements to defeat our attempts of placing her under lawful arrest.

Based on all evidence, facts, and totality of circumstances, I believe I have probable cause Lemoine committed the misdemeanor criminal offense of giving false id to law enforcement as described in FSS 901.-36 (1) - Lemoine was legally detained during a criminal investigation. Lemoine gave a false name even after being asked multiple times to provide her full name and she repeatedly pronounced and spelled the false name.

My BWC and Axon Fleet (3452) were both activated during this incident.

On May 14, 2022, at approximately 1740 hours, Ofc. Hernandez, Ofc. Ham and I, Ofc. Lopez were dispatched near the 1000 block of Atlantic Boulevard.

Upon arrival, Ofc. Hernandez was on scene speaking with a male and a female. Ofc. Hernandez provided me with the male's Florida identification card. I walked back to my patrol vehicle to conduct a name check on the male. The male was identified as Robert Browning, (dob:11/10/1957). While I was conducting a name check inside my patrol vehicle, I heard the female screaming. The female was standing close to Ofc. Hernandez. I walked out of my patrol vehicle, and I began walking towards Ofc. Hernandez. In a matter of seconds the female was laying down on the ground and she was moving her legs as if she was trying to kick Ofc. Ham. Ofc. Hernandez and Ofc. Ham were trying to gain control of the female. I grabbed the female's feet and I held her feet down to the ground to stop her from kicking Ofc. Ham. The female continued moving her legs and feet attempting to free herself. The female continued screaming very loud and being very combative. The female was speaking in an unknown language and then she began threating me several times. The female said to me, "I will fuck you up" and then she said, "I will kill you". Ofc. Hernandez attempted several times to calm down the female and she could not stop her antagonistic demeanor.

The female was later was identified with her Colorado driver's license as Kathryn Lemoine, (dob:05/20/1978).

Kathryn appeared to be under the influence of a narcotic.

Key West Fire Rescue responded on scene to treat the female's injuries. Sgt. D. Kouri responded on scene as well.

This incident was recorded with my body worn camera, 3722.

I later transported Kathryn's bicycle to the Key West Property Division for safekeeping. I completed the property receipt and I placed it in The Key West Property Division.

On May 14, 2022, at approximately 1744 hours, I, Ofc. S. Ham responded to 1000 Atlantic Ave as a back-up officer, reference a lewd and lascivious act.

Upon arrival, Ofc. J. Lopez and Ofc. L. Hernandez were on scene. Ofc. Hernandez was speaking to the male and female attempting to retrieve their identification. I saw on the male's neck what appeared to be scratch marks that were bleeding. The male was later identified as Robert Browning, by his Florida ID card. Ofc. Hernandez passed Roberts ID card to Ofc. Lopez to run his information on his in-car computer.

Ofc. Hernandez then began asking the female half what her name was, and she responded with Dharma. Ofc. Hernandez asked her for her middle name, and she began screaming in an unknown language. The female was later identified by her ID card, as Kathryn Lemoine. Kathryn while screaming began throwing her hand in the air and pointing her finger at myself and Ofc. Hernandez. Kathryn then stood up with haste from the edge of the flower bed and approached Ofc. Hernandez and me. I told Kathryn to sit back down, and she continued walking forward. Ofc. Hernandez placed his arms up to stop Kathryn from walking forward and she swatted his arms away. Kathryn then swung her left elbow at Ofc. Hernandez and struck him in the chest. I grabbed ahold of Kathryn by her right arm as Ofc. Hernandez gained control of her left arm. Ofc. Hernandez and I escorted Kathryn to the ground using a modified straight arm takedown. I handcuffed Kathryn as she continued attempting to pull away and fight with Ofc. Hernandez and I. Ofc. Hernandez gave Kathryn verbal commands to stop resisting. Ofc. Lopez came back from his vehicle and held Kathryn's feet down because she was attempting to kick me in the back. Kathryn continued acting irate on the ground and attempting to pull her legs out of Ofc. Lopez's grasp.

Ofc. Hernandez asked me to go through her backpack to try and find an ID for her. I was unable to locate an ID in the backpack when I heard Ofc. Hernandez ask for me to grab a hobble. I retrieved the hobble from the trunk of my patrol vehicle and placed it around Kathryn's ankles. I secured Kathryn's legs and waited for Key West Rescue personnel to arrive on scene.

I located a blue in color fanny pack behind where Kathryn was sitting. Upon searching the blue handbag, I located an ID out of Colorado belonging to her. I turned the property over to Ofc. Hernandez.

Key West Rescue personnel placed Kathryn on the stretcher and into the back of the ambulance. Key West Rescue personnel asked me to assist them on transport to Lower Keys Medical Center due to her irate behavior. Kathryn had already pulled out of the leg straps on the stretcher and was fighting with rescue personnel, preventing them from treating her. Kathryn was issued a dose of a substance to calm her down. Once Kathryn was calmed, I rode with Key West Rescue without further incident.
