On 5/27/2022 at approximately 1235 hours I, Ofc Standerwick, was on routine patrol of Appelrouth and Duval Street on my KWPD bike when I was flagged down by Isis Santana, Manager Walgreens (527 Duval Street).

Ms. Santana was waving her arms at me and pointing to a white male who was about to urinate in a flower bed next to Walgreens. Ms. Santana advised me the white male, later identified as Jason Kobos (Defendant), had just stolen some items in her store. These items included vitamin gummies and energy tablets for water. The total value of these items was \$37.97. I approached the Defendant who informed me he had to piss. The Defendant had cuts and scrapes on his face and lips and was bleeding from some of the lacerations. Ms. Santana informed me the stolen items were in his waist. I approached the Defendant to detain him, and when I did, I could see some of the stolen items in his waist band. I detained the Defendant by holding onto his right bicep. As soon as I held him the Defendant pulled away and attempted to flee heading South on Duval Street. The Defendant tried to get on his bike to flee, and I was able to grab his arm by Southard and Duval Street. The Defendant continued to pull away from my grasp and I had to struggle with him to the ground. Once on the ground I was straddling the Defendant and he informed me he had given up. I informed the Defendant to roll on his stomach where I commanded him to put his arms behind his back, which he did. The Defendant was handcuffed and brought back to 527 Duval Street. While transporting the Defendant back to the scene I noticed my BWC had fallen off during the struggle. Brian Teague (Witness) found my BWC and returned it to me. Witness Teague also witnessed the altercation and wrote a sworn witness statement for Ofc Stutz. Gregory Gruminski (Witness) also saw the incident and provided a sworn witness statement as well. I contacted Sgt Rodriquez and informed him of the incident, and he responded to the scene. Based on the Defendant's previous injuries I contacted KWFD rescue for first aide for the Defendant. Rescue responded and the Defendant refused treatment. Ofc Stutz and Ofc Waite responded to the scene for assistance with the Defendant who was becoming unruly by cursing and screaming at the top of his lungs. Sgt Rodriguez requested KWFD return to the scene to treat and transport the Defendant to the hospital. While waiting for rescue to respond the Defendant began to yell at the Officers and stand up from a seated position. The Defendant was then repositioned to the ground by Ofc Stutz and Waite. Once on the ground the Defendant kicked the Officers striking Ofc Stutz in the leg multiple times. The Defendant continued lashing out at the Officers with his limbs requiring them to use a hobble on the Defendant. The Defendant was placed in KWFD ambulance where he continued to fight KWFD personal and I in the ambulance and the Defendant kicked me in the jaw with his foot before we were able to restrain him fully. The Defendant was transported to the hospital where he was treated for his injuries and released. While in route to the hospital the Defendant informed me, he was in Walgreens because he fell off his bike and that's why he had cuts on his face. The Defendant said he became upset because he The Defendant was transported to MCSO detention center. The Defendant was also found to have extraditable warrants from Washington State.

Due to the Defendant stealing items worth \$37.97 from Walgreens he is charged with Petit Theft.

Due to the Defendant resisting me by fleeing me he is charged with Resisting without Violence.

Due to the Defendant kicking and striking Ofc Stutz and Myself he is charged 2 counts of Battery on Law enforcement officer.

Due to the Defendant resisting Officers on scene with violence he is charged with resisting with violence.

On Friday, May 27, 2022, at approximately 1235 hours, I responded to the area of 527 Duval St., Walgreens, to assist Ofc. Standerwick who advised he had a resisting subject in custody.

On arrival, I observed Ofc. Standerwick had the subject, later identified as Jason Kobos, detained in handcuffs standing near the Walgreens. Ofc. Standerwick advised the subject tried to flee on a bicycle when he was flagged down about the incident. Kobos made multiple spontaneous utterance reference to the retail theft he had just committed, which were captured on my BWC.

Ofc. Standerwick requested I obtain written statements from two passers-by that witnessed the incident. I obtained the statements and later provided them to Ofc. Standerwick.

Upon returning, I observed Kobos was now seated in handcuffs and was screaming at passer-bys that he was a "Hell's Angel". Kobos continued this behavior for several minutes while crying. Ofc. Standerwick then requested myself, Ofc. Waite, and Ofc. Rojas standby with Kobos while he moved his patrol vehicle closer to the location. After Ofc. Standerwick left, Kobos continued screaming then tried to stand up. I told Kobos to remain seated and he lunged toward me knocking my BWC to the ground. Kobos fell backward after running into me and began kicking upward at my chest and face in an attempt to strike me. Kobos landed several kicks on my legs and chest. Ofc. Waite, Ofc. Rojas and I turned Kobos onto his stomach and immobilized his legs so he could no longer try to kick us. Kobos was later placed in a hobble by Ofc. Waite to secure his feet.

Kobos was later transported from the scene by Key West Fire Rescue for evaluation at Lower Keys Medical Center.

My BWC was activated during this incident and entered into evidence.
