SUBJECT: Lazy Way Lane Pedestrian Promenade Pilot Program

ACTION STATEMENT

Approve a pilot program to create a Lazy Way Lane Pedestrian Promenade between William and Elizabeth Streets.

BACKGROUND

This pilot program, with the intention of improving public safety, would limit Lazy Way Lane to non-motorized traffic, ADA-compliant vehicles, and vehicles essential for maintenance, repairs and time-sensitive commercial activities related directly to public and private property along Lazy Way Lane from 6:00 pm to 4:00 am daily, for a period of up to one year. The City Manager will be authorized to temporarily suspend or adjust the pedestrian promenade hours whenever necessary in the interests of public safety or upon declaration of public emergency.

STRATEGIC PLAN

The Lazy Way Pedestrian Promenade addresses the Strategic Plan, *Key West Forward*, Priority 6, Goal 1, Action 12: "Shared Street" Pilot in Old Town.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact associated with this pilot project.

RECOMMENDATION

Recommend approving a pilot program to create a Lazy Way Lane Pedestrian Promenade.
