A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING ATTACHED "POINCIANA **GARDENS** TRANSPORTATION INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT" BETWEEN HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF WEST (KWHA); AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 13-256, the City encouraged KWHA to develop and construct an assisted living facility at Poinciana Plaza, in Resolution 20-031 the City Commission acknowledged the management challenges faced by the Poinciana Gardens senior living facility, and found that the Poinciana Gardens facility provides safe and affordable housing for senior citizens in Key West, and in Resolution No. 21-174, the City and the County committed to providing certain funding to KWHA for FY 2022 through 2024 for the continued operation of Poinciana Gardens; and

WHEREAS, the Poinciana Gardens Emergency Management Plan requires transportation services for up to fifty-eight assisted living residents to a facility on the mainland in the event of a threat of a category 3 or higher hurricane approaching, and the City of Key West has staff and vehicles to support this need; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that an Interlocal Agreement to provide hurricane evacuation transportation services upon certain terms and conditions would benefit the residents of Poinciana Gardens and the City of Key West; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission hereby approves the attached "Poinciana Gardens Transportation Interlocal Agreement" between the City and the Key West Housing Authority to provide transportation for assisted living residents in the event of a threat of a category 3 or higher hurricane approaching, upon certain terms and conditions.

Section 2: That costs for such hurricane evacuation transportation shall be reimbursed to the City by KWHA if not otherwise reimbursed by FEMA, or other agency or organization. Any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby approved.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute this Interlocal Agreement and related documents upon consent of the City Attorney.
