On June 18, 2022, at approximately 1420 hours, Ofc Stevens, Ofc S Perez and I (Ofc Betz) responded to 1221 Duval St, VIP Gentlemen's Club, in reference to a male, possibly high on cocaine, who had scared the employee to the point she had hidden behind a locked door. All officers who responded were wearing their issued KWPD uniforms, which made us readily recognizable as police officers.

Ofc Stevens arrived just moments before I did. As I approached the business, I could hear an employee yelling at a person, later identified as Jamie Venerio, to "Get the fuck out". The employee ordered Venerio three times to "Get the fuck out." I observed Venerio, whose clothes were strewed across the lobby floor, standing there naked and made no attempt to get dressed and leave upon demand.

Julia Matus, the employee who was frightened by Venerio announced that Venerio had a bag of cocaine. I asked Matus where the bag of cocaine was located. Matus walked me to room #6, where she was working and pointed to an empty baggie on the table. The baggie had a small amount of white power in the bag. Matus also gave me Venerio's license. Ofc Perez arrived on scene.

Ofc Stevens, Ofc Perez and I asked Venerio several times to put his clothes on. Venerio did not comply and asked us if those were his clothes. We explained to him that we were uncertain whose clothes they were, since we were not there when he put them on. We added that he should know if they were his. Ofc Perez placed Venerio into handcuffs. Venerio tried to pull away from Ofc Perez as he handcuffed him. Ofc Perez told Venerio several times to "Stop resisting" as he finally got him into handcuffs. Venerio became very paranoid and kept asking Ofc Perez what he was putting in his hands. We walked Venerio over to a bench and told him to sit down. Venerio refused to sit down. Ofc Perez and I told Venerio several times to have a seat, since this would have allowed us to put his shorts on to cover his exposed penis. Venerio again refused. Venerio tried pulling away from Ofc Perez and I and pushed against us as we tried to have him sit down. Venerio also kicked me a couple times as we tried to have him sit down.

Matus again told me that Venerio had another baggie of cocaine in his wallet. I checked his wallet and located a clear plastic baggie containing a white powdery substance. The cards in the wallet did belong to Venerio. Ofc Steven's later field tested the substance which tested positive for cocaine.

I called for EMS to respond to check Venerio's vitals due to my observations of him. We attempted to wrap Venerio in a sheet in order to walk him out to a patrol vehicle. Venerio tried to pull away several times, to prevent us from wrapping him with the sheet. Once Ofc Stevens was able to cover up Venerio's nether region, Ofc Perez and I escorted Venerio to his patrol vehicle. Once at the patrol vehicle, Venerio refused to sit in the car. We tried several times to get Venerio in the vehicle, but were not successful. During the struggle to place Venerio in the car, he kicked at me again, striking me in the right leg.

Ofc Perez applied the Taser to Venerio's thigh and drive stunned him in an effort to gain compliance. Venerio was not effected by the Taser. I used a knee spike to Venerio's thigh in an attempt to gain compliance from his in order to get him into the car. The knee spike was not effective. We decided to sit Venerio on the ground and wait for EMS to arrive. EMS arrived and transported Venerio to LKMC for evaluation.

I spoke to Matus about the incident. She said Venerio was "acting high on cocaine" and was causing her alarm due to his bizzarre behavior. She said she was worried about her safety, so she exited the room. She said Vererio

followed her, which allowed her to get him into the lobby. She told me during the session, Venerio kept reaching for the bag of cocaine in his wallet and told her that the cocaine needed to be "broken up". She said once he started acting strangley, she asked him to leave, but he did not.

I arrived at LKMC. Ofc Perez walked Venerio to my patrol vehicle once he was medically cleared. I transported Venerio to MCDC for processing.

Since Venerio did remain on the property of 1221 Duval St after being ordered to "Get the fuck out" three times by staff, Venerio was in violation of FSS 810.08.

Since Venerio did attempt to pull away from Ofc Perez as he was attempting to handcuff him and also attempted to defeat our attempts to place him in a patrol vehicle, Venerio was in violation of FSS 843.02.

Since Venerio did kick at me, Ofc Betz, while we attempted to place him in his patrol vehicle, Venerio was in violation of FSS 843.01.

Since Venerio was in possession of FTP cocaine, he was in violation of FSS 893.13-6a.

There is BWC for this case.

On June 18, 2022, Ofcs Betz, S. Perez and I responded to the "VIP Gentleman's Club", 1221 Duval St, Key West, Florida, in reference to a mentally disturbed person. Dispatch advised that the caller became frightened of a male patron who had taken cocaine and was acting erratically. The caller, later identified as Julia MATUS, had locked herself in the back of the premises and the male was in the lobby.

Upon arrival, as I walked toward the premises, a female was running across the street to 1221 Duval St. She ran up the front stairs and entered the establishment. I asked her if she had called and she said yes. As I walked through the front door, I could hear her shouting at someone to "get the fuck out". I then saw a white male, later identified as Jaime VENERIO, standing in the lobby completely naked. There were various items of clothing in front of him on the floor. The female continued to shout at him to get out and he demanded his clothes.

I asked him, "what's your deal?" and he told me that a female had asked him to take off his clothes and then she threw them out here (to the lobby). He and the female continued to argue loudly and I became aware of another person on the other side of a door which leads to the interior of the establishment who was also shouting through the door. Ofc Betz went to speak with her and Ofc Perez and I asked VENERIO to put his clothes on. Ofc Perez gave him some boxer shorts that were on the floor and asked him to put them on and VENERIO refused. He asked Ofc Perez to put them down, saying it was not his. He said that "she took my clothes and then she threw it out here".

Ofc Betz emerged from the back of the premises and showed us a small cellophane baggie which appeared to contain white powder. We continued to implore him to put his clothes on and he refused. Ofc Betz said that he would be placed under arrest and VENERIO said okay, however he continued to refuse to put any clothes on, saying that he did not know whose clothes were on the floor. He said that he did not want to put his clothes on. Ofc Betz told him to put his hands behind his back and Ofc Perez and I attempted to handcuff him. As we did, he started to accuse us of putting something in his hands and of putting something on his handcuffs. Once I had applied and double-locked the handcuffs, we asked him to sit on a bench in the lobby and he refused. Ofcs Betz and Perez struggled with him to gain compliance. I went to speak with the caller, MATUS, and as I walked to the back of the establishment, I heard loud shouting coming from the lobby, as Ofcs Perez and Betz told VENERIO to sit down and VENERIO continued to shout back at them.

MATUS said that she had taken VENERIO to one of the rooms and she said that she sensed he "was on something" and she offered to get him a towel "to clean up". He asked her for his shorts and she pointed them out to him. She said that she felt like he was trying to get her into a vulnerable position to "assault" her. She then walked out of the room to go to the lobby and he followed her, demanding his shorts. When they both got to the lobby, she turned around and went back through the door, locking him in the lobby. She then retrieved his clothes and threw them out to him. He continued to demand his shorts, even after she repeatedly pointed to them on the floor in front of him.

I then returned to the lobby, where Ofcs Betz and Perez were still arguing with VENERIO who was refusing to comply with them. I then consulted privately with Ofc Betz. Ofc Perez continued to gain compliance from VENERIO who was shouting over him. Ofc Betz and I returned to the lobby and VENERIO continued to shout, demanding that we record the interaction. We informed him that we were recording him. Staff gave me a sheet to wrap VENERIO in to take him outside. Since he refused to put on any clothes, I attempted to wrap the sheet around him in order that we could take him outside. Ofc Betz located VENERIO's wallet and displayed to us a bag of white powder that was concealed within. He repeatedly resisted my efforts to put the sheet around his waist by twisting his body around and lifting his legs. He was shouting that it was illegal for us to put a sheet around him and he was asking where the cameras were. Once we got the sheet around his waist, Ofc Betz summoned an ambulance, citing concerns of cocaine psychosis. I also summoned Sgt Sims and after continued to argue with VENERIO, Ofcs Betz and Perez escorted VENERIO outside, while I gathered VERNERIO's belongings.

Outside, VENERIO continued to scream and resist officers efforts to escort him across the street to Ofc Perez` car. VENERIO`s sheet came off his body and he was naked as Ofcs Betz and PEREZ attempted to place VENERIO into the backseat of Ofc Perez` patrol vehicle. VENERIO kicked at officers and twisted and tensed his body to defeat their efforts to secure him. Ofc Perez delievered a drive stun with his Taser device in order to obtain pain compliance, but VENERIO continued to fight and struggle against the officers.

Ofcs Perez and Betz elected to seat him on the sidewalk outside of the car in order to await the ambulance's arrival. I attempted again to cover VENERIO with a sheet as he was completely naked and there were multitudes of people observing him, but he managed to discard the sheet. I then field-tested the white powder that Ofc Betz had discovered in VENERIO's wallet and it field-tested postive (FTP) for cocaine.

When Key West Fire/Rescue arrived, they evaluated VENERIO, who told them that he wanted to go to the hospital. Sgt Sims arrived and spoke with officers on scene, in addition to VENERIO. He elected to have Ofc Perez ride in the ambulance with VENERIO to the hospital. I drove to the hospital with VENERIO's belongings and surrendered them to Ofc Perez to give to Ofc Betz upon his arrival.

By bodyworn camera (BWC) was activated and recording during the entire incident.

On Friday, June 18, 2022, at approximately 1423 hours, I, Officer Santiago Perez was dispatched to the VIP Gentleman Club, located at 1221 Duval Street to assist Officer Stevens, reference an individual inside the club under the influence of Cocaine refusing to leave the premises.

On my arrival Officer Stevens and Officer Betz were inside the club. I entered the Club and found both officers and a naked individual inside holding his hands up and refusing to obey all and any commands made by the officers. I also asked the individual to put his clothes on while we investigated the incident, and he ignored my commands as well. After several tries to get the individual dressed, we decided to place him in custody. I handcuffed the individual, in the handcuffing process, The induvial tensed his right arm and pulled away attempting to prevent from been handcuffed. Officer Betz searched the individual wallet looking for an identification and found his Florida Driver's License along with two clear plastic bags containing a white powdery substance. The individual was later identified as Jaime Venerio (DOB 10/04/1976). Venerio was acting irrational and appear to be under Cocaine induced psychosis.

Officer Stevens got a bed sheet from the club, and we were able to cover Venerio's private parts as we took him out to my vehicle. Officer Betz and I walked Venerio out to my vehicle and Venerio refused to enter the vehicle, Venerio stiffed his body and actively resisted our verbal commands, furthermore Venerio kicked Officer Betz while traying to seat him in the vehicle. I took out my department issued taser, removed the cartridge and told Venerio I was going to tased him if he continues to refuse to enter in the vehicle. Venerio ignored my command once again and I drive stunt Venerio on his right leg. Venerio had no response to been tasered and continue to refuse to get in my patrol vehicle, at that point I asked Officer Betz, to sit him on the sidewalk as we waited for Key West Fire Rescue to respond to our location to be medically check due to his behavior.

Key West Fire Rescue transported Venerio to the Lower Keys Medical Center emergency room for clearance. I rode in the ambulance to secure the safety of the rescue personnel. During transport to the emergency room, Venerio calms down and was very cooperative. I stayed with Venerio at the hospital until he was medically cleared. Officer Betz took Venerio in custody and transported him to the Monroe County Detention Center

My Body Worn Camera was activated during my interaction with Venerio and later uploaded into evidence.com as evidence. I had no further involvement on this case.
