**A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR
AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT
AGENCY (CRA) REJECTING ALL BIDS RECEIVED IN
RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #22-008
MARGARET STREET FIRE PUMP BUILDING - KEY WEST
HISTORIC SEAPORT PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-834(3)
AND(4) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING
FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the bids received in response to ITB 22-008 exceeded cost estimates and were not balanced. Accordingly, staff recommends rejecting the bids received and re-bidding the project; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of August 10, 2022, the Key West Bight Management District Board recommended that the CRA reject the bids received in response to ITB 22-008 through Resolution 22-09; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the all bids received in response to ITB #22-008, for Margaret Street Fire Pump Building - Key West Historic Seaport are hereby rejected pursuant to city code of ordinances section 2-834(3) and (4).

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency.
