A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING TASK ORDER 3-22 SWR FOR CH2M HILL/JACOBS ENGINEERING GROUP IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO \$160,382.37 FOR **ENGINEERING** EXCEED DESIGN, PERMITTING AND BID PHASE SERVICES FOR REHABILITATION OF PUMP STATION "G"; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY TRANSFERS AND ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 17-207, the City Commission approved a contract with CH2M Hill, Inc. for General Engineering Services and in Resolution 20-142 the Agreement was extended for two years and in Resolution 22-171 the Agreement was extended through December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 21-006, the City Commission acknowledged the merger of CH2M Hill Companies, Ltd. with Jacobs Engineering Group, and the use of the Jacobs name for the remainder of the contract term; and

WHEREAS, this task order will include design tasks related to upgrades to add, replace and repair deteriorating equipment for pump station "G," as recommended in the 2015 Pump Station Condition Assessment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Task Order No. 3-22 SWR from CH2M HILL/Jacobs Engineering Group for engineering design, permitting and bid phase services for rehabilitation of Pump Station G is hereby approved in an amount not to exceed \$160,382.37.

Section 2: That this project is budgeted in Construction in Progress/Pump Station Rehab 4, Account No. 401-3503-535-6500, and any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
