#### -- Victor De Jesus Ramos Arrest Narrative:

On Tuesday August 16, 2022, at about 1905 hours, I, (ofc. L. Hernandez), was on patrol within the City of Key West limits, when I saw a male matching the description of a suspect that had walked out on a \$82.24 tab at a local restaurant. The incident occurred at 917 Duval Street (Martin's Restaurant and Steakhouse). I was driving in the area of 525 Duval Street when I saw the male, later identified as Victor De Jesus Ramos (DOB 07/15/1989) (Arrestee), identified by his Florida driver's license.

The description given by Martin's staff was a Hispanic male wearing a Hawaiian shirt and blue shorts. Victor matched the description and was wearing the clothing as described. I asked Victor to step over to 515 in front of Coach Factory so we can talk. Victor complied. I asked Victor what happened, and he said, "I was kicked out of the restaurant by the server, I am going to sue them, I wanted to pay the bill, but they said they did not accept apple pay so I gave them a credit card, but the card declined payment". I asked Victor if he had any other means to pay several times and he said no. Victor began to act belligerent, speaking and yelling over me, as he was doing so, he was looking around across the street and on both south and north sides of Duval Street as if he was trying to gather an audience. Victor was screaming from the top of his lungs at times saying, "you are not listening to me" and making multiple incoherent statements. Victor was under the influence of alcoholic intoxicant (s) as per his slurred speech, strong odor of alcoholic beverages emanating from his breath and person, watery glassy eyes. Victor began to walk away from me, and I gave him loud and cleared commands to stop. Victor complied and said, "come on Hernandez, we are the same, we are Hispanics" as he was oddly laughing.

Ofc. E. Andrade was at 917 Duval Street speaking with the server that waited on Victor. Ofc. Andrade told me that Nathan Tomlinson Neely (DOB 10/02/1975) (Martin's server), said the owners want to pursue criminal charges if Victor is not able and willing to pay. I asked Victor again if he was able and willing to pay and he said no. Victor said, "I want to go over there, have a sit and drink some water". I then told Victor that was not going to happen, and I informed him he was committing a crime if he was not able to pay the tab. Victor proceeded to show me an app on his phone saying, "they would not accept this as payment". I told Victor he is not able to pay with that and I asked if he had any other means to pay, and he said no. Victor tried walking away from me, I gave him loud and clear commands to stop. Victor grabbed his cellphone and began to make a phone call. I told Victor to put his phone away and to sit down. Victor said he was not, I unholstered my taser, pointe at Victor and I gave loud and clear commands to sit on the adjacent curb and he eventually did, I placed Victor in handcuffs, checked them for tightness and double locked them. Victor kept trying to draw a crowd by screaming. I escorted Victor to my patrol vehicle, and I ordered him to face the vehicle and widen his stands. I began to conduct a search incident to arrest of Victor. Victor told me "Why are you searching me?" I answered because you are under arrest. Victor then began to tense up and made attempts to walk away from me. I kept telling Victor to stop moving and to stop resisting. Victor would not comply and when I realized he was trying to get away by pulling towards the rear of my vehicle, and would not listen to my lawful, loud, and clear multiple commands I tried to sit him down, but he threw his body against me hitting me with his shoulders on my chest area. Victor also tried to head butt me but missed. Due to Victor's aggressive resistance and to control the situation from escalating to a more volatile situation and for his safety and my safety I grabbed Victor by his shoulders and brought him down to the ground in a control manner and placed him on his side. Victor did not suffer any injuries during the use of force. Victor was screaming from the top of his lungs "please do not kill me, that is what you guys do, please do not kill me". I kept telling Victor to calm down.

Ofc. E. Andrade arrived on scene and assisted me with placing Victor in the rear of my patrol vehicle. Axon Fleet rear camera activated. I transported Victor to the Monroe County Detention Center where he was turned over to

Detention Deputies with no issues. During transport Victor asked me several times to turn off the cameras while saying "we can resolve this, I know people, I do not want to drop any names, we are the same".

Based on all facts, evidence, and totality of circumstances, I believe I have probable cause Victor committed the felony criminal offense of battery on law enforcement officer as described in FSS 784.07-2B - Victor knowingly and intentionally hit me and tried to head butt me. I was on duty with my Class B Key West Police issued uniform during my encounter with Victor which clearly identifies me as a law enforcement officer.

Based on all facts, evidence, and totality of circumstances, I believe I have probable cause Victor committed the felony criminal offense of resisting an officer with violence as described in FSS 843.01 - Victor knowingly and willfully resisted me by pulling away, tensing up, making attacking movements at me which forced me to use a reasonable response to resistance and necessary to prevent him from hurting me or himself.

Based on all facts, evidence, and totality of circumstances, I believe I have probable cause Victor committed the misdemeanor criminal offense of defraud an innkeeper as described in FSS 509.151 - Victor obtained foods and beverages from Martin's with the intent to not pay. Victor walked on a \$82.24 dollar tab. Victor consumed the goods of the food service establishment and provided no means to pay.

Based on all facts, evidence, and totality of circumstances, I believe I have probable cause Victor committed the misdemeanor criminal offense of disorderly conduct as described in FSS 877.03 - Victor's acts and behavior corrupted the public morals and affected the peace and quiet. Victor engaged in resisting a law enforcement officer by fighting which drew a substantial crowd. Bystanders were stopping by and filming the incident from the same side of Duval we were on and also across the street.

Sgt. A. Rodriguez arrived on scene, reviewed incident and completed required response to resitance investigation.

My BWC and Axon Fleet (3452) were both activated during this incident.

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End of report. Cleared by arrest.
