On Monday, August 29, 2022, at approximately 1442 hours, I, Officer Jesse Young, was working an off duty detail at 245 Front St. (Pier B Cruise Ship Terminal).

I was checking Identification Cards and Ship Cards in the Eastern line when I heard a commotion from the area where Cruise Ship Agent Greg Whipple was seated minutes earlier. I stopped checking passenger ID's as my attention was directed towards the commotion from the containment area of where passengers are directed to stand who forget their Identification.

I heard a male, later identified as Jacob Stutes by his Louisiana Driver's License, being verbally abusive towards Whipple. Stutes was speaking in a tone of voice to disrupt the flow of passengers getting back on the ship. I stood by and observed Stutes as he was making statements that with him being pulled aside was due to immigration reasons and that other ships have never required anyone to produce identification. I saw Stutes aggressively produce his ship card to Whipple and instructed him to board the ship and retrieve his ID. Stutes continued to be loud and disruptive as he was restating that he has never been required to produce an ID and he was never told an ID was required to board the ship.

I spoke up towards Stutes and gained his attention to stop his tyrant rant and I instructed him that he had been told his ID was required to board the ship. I explained that there was a ship announcement prior to reaching the dock this morning. It was posted on the ship prior to exiting the gangway, a two foot by four foot sign prior to reaching the pier exit. There was also a verbal recording at or near the exit gate.

Stutes then aggressively put his ship card in my face and told me to go get his ID. I declined.

Stutes vocal tone continued to get louder, causing a further disturbance with the cruise ship passengers. With the escalation of Stutes's behavior, being unverified as a ship passenger and attempting to incite negative responses from other passengers in line. Whipple instructed Stutes he had to leave the pier as ship security had to come out to him and verify him as a passenger. Stutes refused to leave. I instructed Stutes to leave as I opened the removable gate towards the exit. Stutes again refused to leave physically so I grabbed a hold of Stutes's right wrist and placed him into a bent wrist transporter. At no time did I have to apply pressure to Stutes's wrist as he now became compliant and we walked to the exit gate of the pier.

After we exited the cruise ship terminal exit gate I released my grasp of Stutes. Stutes still was extremely agitated and spoke out that he did not like Whipple and he "Needed an attitude adjustment". Stutes continued to make negative statements towards the situation which occurred. Stutes made claims that he has a lawyer and he would sue as he felt that he was singled out and he believed he was treated badly by Whipple.

I explained that Stutes was not welcome at the pier and if he were able to be identified or produce an ID he would be let back on the ship. Stutes opened his bi-fold wallet / cell phone holder and exhibited his Louisiana ID to me. Stutes made a statement that he did not produce his ID because his husband did not have his and did not want him to stand alone while his identification was verified. I instructed Stutes since he now has his ID, he may rejoin the line and be allowed on the ship.

I monitored Stutes's behavior from a distance as he went through the security checkpoint, still adjugated and less vocal than he was previously observed.
