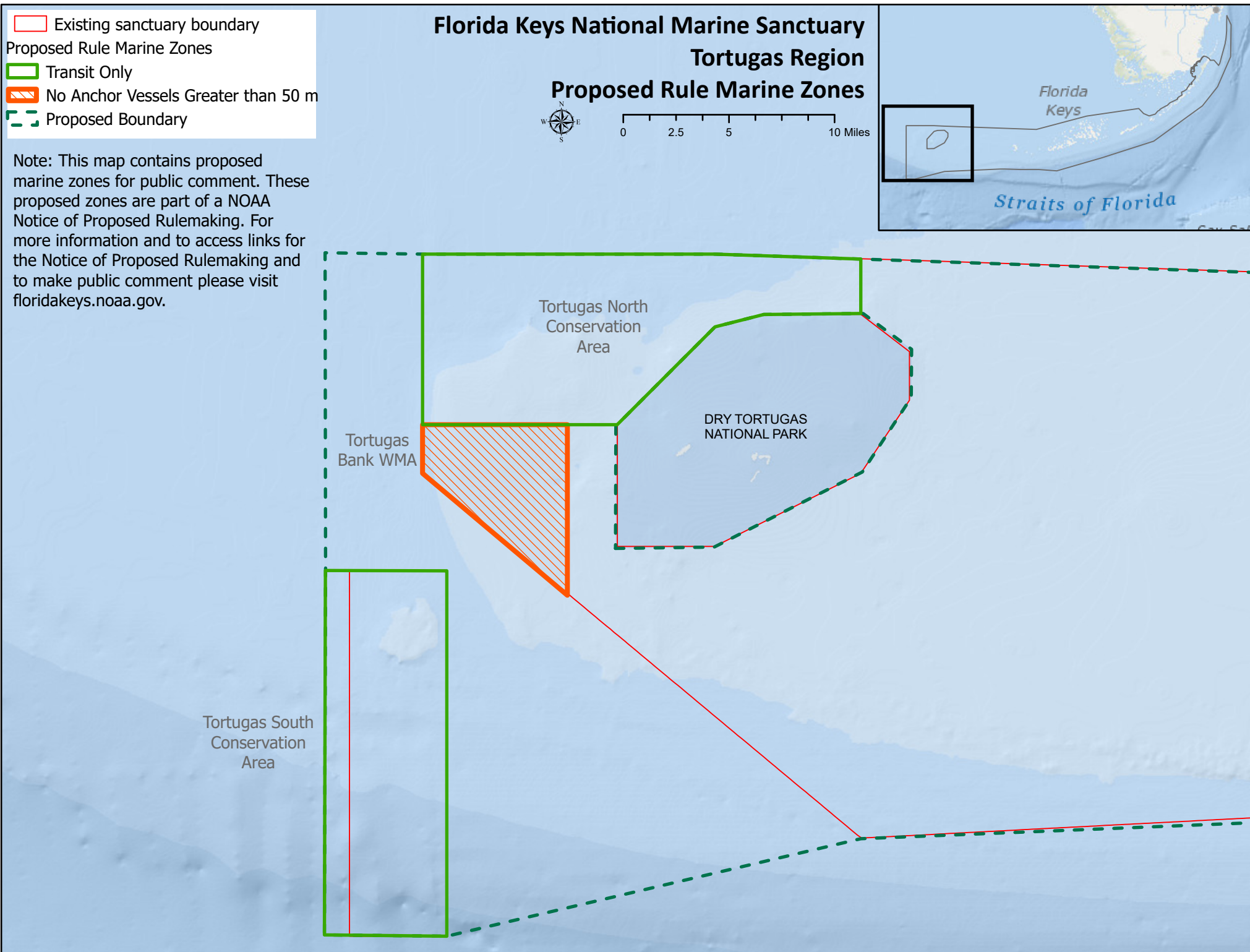


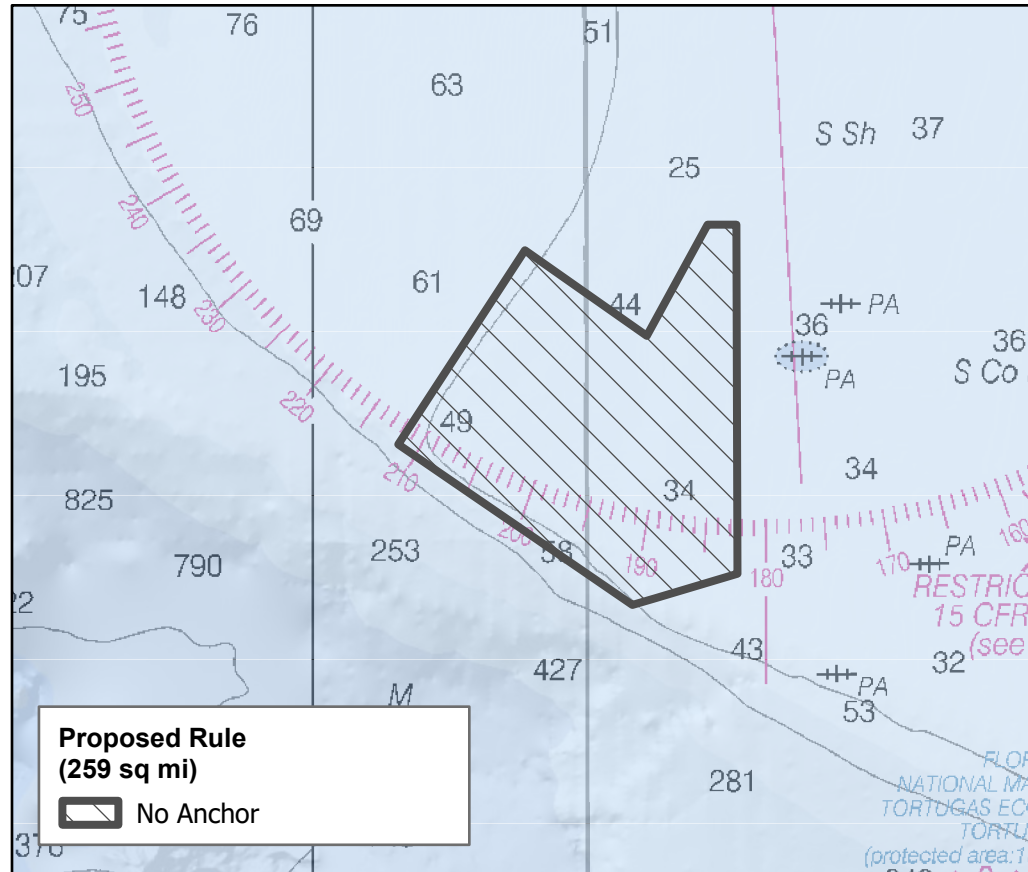
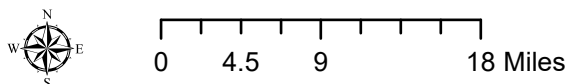
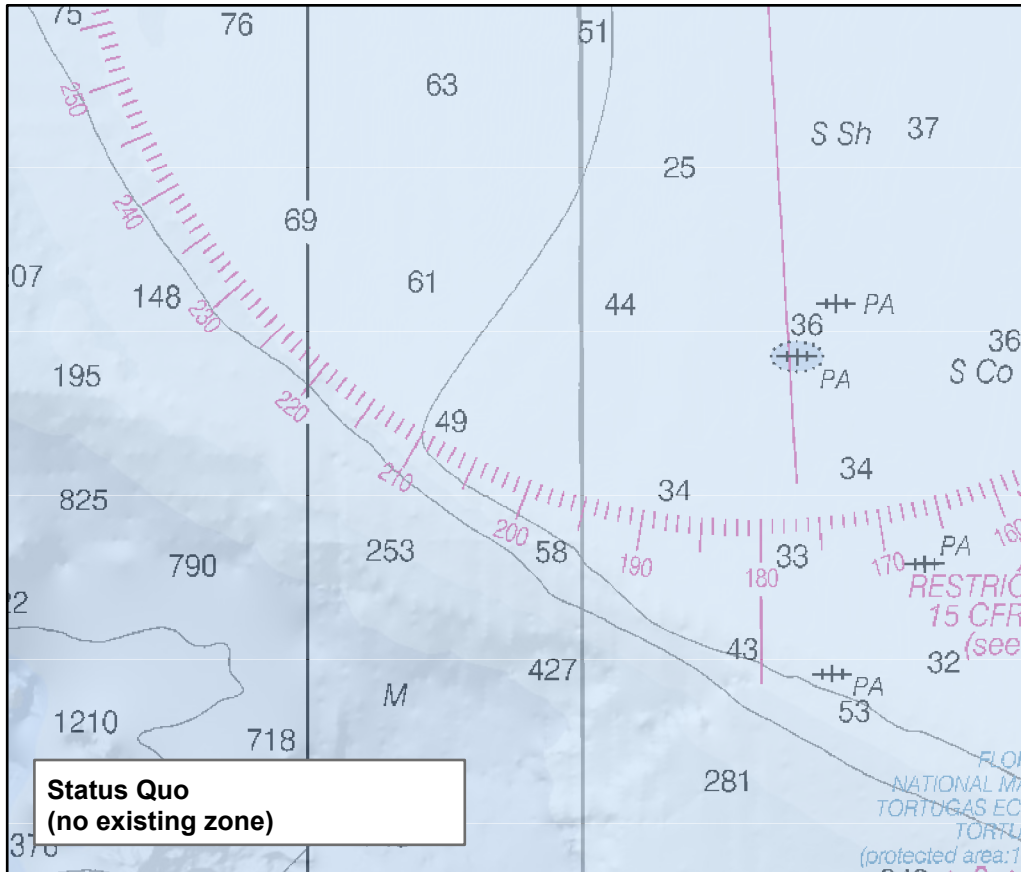


Tortugas Region: Marine Zones

Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary

Pulley Ridge Sanctuary Boundary Expansion and Wildlife Management Area

Protects nationally-significant mesophotic reef ecosystems with demonstrated connectivity to the Florida Keys. This area also includes endemic species. This zone overlaps with an existing Gulf of Mexico Fishery Management Council Habitat Area of Particular Concern (HAPC).
