**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE KEY WEST ART CENTER TO CONDUCT IT'S 37<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL CRAFT FESTIVAL SHOW ON SATURDAY, JANUARY 28, 2023 AND SUNDAY, JANUARY 29, 2023, DURING THE HOURS OF 10:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M.; (SET UP AT 6:00 A.M) PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF WHITEHEAD STREET BETWEEN GREENE STREET AND EATON STREETS INCLUDING CAROLINE FROM TELEGRAPH TO WHITEHEAD STREET AND CAROLINE STREET AND TRUMAN ANNEX ON JANUARY 28, 2023 AND JANUARY 29, 2023 FROM 6:00 A.M. TO 8:00 P.M: PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS** The Key West Art Center wishes to conduct a Craft Festival Show on the day and during the hours stated above, and

**WHEREAS** The Key West Art Center anticipates that over 20,000 people will be participating in the events.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

**SECTION 1.** That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city Manager to “develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law”

**SECTION 2.** “That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City’s concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore, commits to refrain from the use or distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic

items, including but not limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and “to go” packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City”

**SECTION 3.** That the Key West Art Center is hereby granted permission to conduct a Craft Festival Show on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

**SECTION 4.** That the Key West Art Center is hereby granted permission for the closure of Whitehead Street between Greene Street and Eaton Street including Caroline Street from Telegraph Lane to Whitehead Street on the date and during the hours stated above.

**SECTION 5.** That the Key West Art Center will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

**SECTION 6.** That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by the Commission or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID-19 in the community.

**SECTION 7.** That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
